3	Ordinance authorizing settlement of the lawsuit filed by Alexis Krup against the City
4	and County of San Francisco for \$3,325,000; the lawsuit was filed on October 9, 2020,
5	in San Francisco Superior Court, Case No. CGC-20-587218; entitled <u>Alexis Krup v. City</u>
