3	Resolution retroactively approving an agreement between the San Francisco
4	Department of Public Health and the San Francisco Unified School District having
5	anticipated revenue to the City of \$1,000,000 or more for students with disabilities to
6	receive special education and educationally related mental health services; and to
7	authorize the Department of Public Health to enter into amendments or modifications to
8	the agreement prior to its final execution by all parties that do not materially increase
9	the obligations or liabilities to the City and are necessary to effectuate the purposes of
10	the agreement or this Resolution.
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12	WHEREAS, The San Francisco Unified School District (SFUSD), in accordance with
13	the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA, 2004), is solely responsible for ensuring
14	that students with disabilities receive special education and educationally related mental
15	health services (ERMHS) to meet their needs; and
16	WHEREAS, The Department of Public Health (DPH) provides educationally related
17	mental health services for SFUSD under an agreement with SFUSD having anticipated
18	revenue to the City of \$1,000,000 or more (Agreement); and
19	WHEREAS, Charter, Section 9.118 requires contracts entered by a department having
20	anticipated revenue to the City of \$1,000,000 or more be approved by the San Francisco
21	Board of Supervisors by Resolution; and
22	WHEREAS, A draft of the Agreement is on file with the Clerk of the Board of
23	Supervisors in File No. 230433, which is hereby declared to be a part of this Resolution as if
24	set forth fully herein; now, therefore, be it

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1	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Director of Health to
2	retroactively enter into the Agreement having anticipated revenue to the City of \$1,000,000 or
3	more; and, be it
4	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Director
5	of Health to enter into any amendments or modifications to this agreement, prior to its final
6	execution by all parties, that the Department determines, in consultation with the City
7	Attorney, are in the best interests of the City, do not otherwise materially increase the
8	obligations or liabilities of the City, are necessary or advisable to effectuate the purposes of
9	the agreement, and are in compliance with all applicable laws; and, be it
10	FURTHER RESOLVED, That within thirty (30) days of the Agreement being fully
11	executed by all parties, the Director of Health shall provide the final agreement to the Clerk of
12	the Board for inclusion in File No. 230433,
