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

1	[Supporting Julie Su for United States Labor Secretary]

3	Resolution supporting Julie Su and urging her timely confirmation as United States				
4	Secretary of Labor.

6	WHEREAS, Julie Su started her legal career as a civil rights attorney, working as a				
7	litigation director for the Asian Pacific American Legal Center, now known as Asian Americans				
8	Advancing Justice; and				
9	WHEREAS, In this role, Julie Su fought for the most marginalized and vulnerable				
10	workers, winning a precedent-setting case in the El Monte Thai Garment Slavery Case, which				
11	won \$4 million in stolen wages for trafficked garment workers and led to the creation of the T-				
12	Visa for victims of human trafficking; and				
13	WHEREAS, In 2011, Governor Jerry Brown appointed Julie Su as Labor				
14	Commissioner, heading the California Division of Labor Standards Enforcement, where she				
15	enforced wage and labor laws and led a campaign prioritizing cases of wage theft; and				
16	WHEREAS, In 2019, Governor Gavin Newsom appointed Julie Su as Labor Secretary				
17	of California's Labor and Workforce Development Agency, overseeing unemployment				
18	benefits, labor law, workplace safety enforcement, and jobs training programs; and				
19	WHEREAS, In February of 2021, after a lobbying effort by the Asian American				
20	community and the Congressional Asian Pacific American Caucus, President Joe Biden				
21	nominated Julie Su to be the Deputy Secretary of Labor under Secretary Marty Walsh; and				
22	WHEREAS, After confirmation hearings in the Senate Health, Education, Labor and				
23	Pensions Committee, Julie Su was confirmed to the role of Deputy Secretary of Labor on July				
24	13, 2021, in a 50-47 vote, and has been a driving force in federal investments in economic				
25	opportunities for all American workers; and				

1 WHEREAS, In 2023, when Secretary Marty Walsh announced that he was stepping 2 down as Secretary of Labor, President Joe Biden nominated Su to serve as the United States 3 Secretary of Labor on February 8, 2023; and 4 WHEREAS, Due to her long career and groundbreaking advances in fighting against 5 wage theft, enforcing workplace safety standards and protecting the rights of our most 6 vulnerable workers, Julie Su's nomination has garnered broad support across elected officials, 7 labor leaders, the Asian America and Native Hawaiian and Pacific Islander community, and 8 other community advocates, including former United States Secretary of Labor Marty Walsh; 9 now, therefore, be it 10 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco 11 stands in strong support of Julie Su and urges her timely confirmation as United States

12 Secretary of Labor; and, be it
