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3	Resolution approving Diego Lane, Loquat Lane, Meyer Lane, and Wisteria Lane as the

7	WHEREAS, On August 18, 2020, in Ordinance No. 142-20, the Board of Supervisors
8	(the "Board" or "Board of Supervisors") approved a Development Agreement for the Balboa
9	Reservoir Project (the "Project"), a mixed income housing development of up to approximately
10	1,100 housing units, including approximately 550 units affordable to low and moderate-income
11	households, and approximately four acres of publicly accessible open spaces, among other
12	uses; and
13	WHEREAS, The Project is located generally north of the Ocean Avenue Commercial
14	District, west of City College of San Francisco Ocean Campus, east of the Westwood Park
15	neighborhood, and south of Archbishop Riordan High School; and
16	WHEREAS, Under the Development Agreement, the Project sponsor will construct and
17	dedicate public streets within and adjacent to the Project area for residents of the Project, the
18	community, and the public (collectively the "Public Streets"); and
19	WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors anticipates dedicating these Public Streets as
20	open public right of way through subsequent actions and accepting the Public Streets and
21	attendant public infrastructure for City maintenance and liability purposes subject to certain
22	conditions; and
23	WHEREAS, To avoid public confusion with street names and create a consistent and
24	comprehensive street naming nomenclature applicable to this multi-year phased Project, this
25	Resolution proposes to officially name Public Streets within the Project area; and

Supervisor Melgar BOARD OF SUPERVISORS WHEREAS, The proposed street names for the Public Streets ("Proposed Street
Names") are, in alphabetical order: Diego Lane, Loquat Lane, Meyer Lane, and Wisteria Lane,
and are shown in their approximate locations on a map that is on file with the Clerk of the
Board of Supervisors in File No. 230138 and incorporated herein by reference; and
WHEREAS, In a companion Resolution, the Board of Supervisors is renaming a portion
of existing Lee Avenue and naming a future extension of this street to Mayor Edwin M. Lee
Avenue; and

8 WHEREAS, Future Mayor Edwin M. Lee Avenue, a part of the construction of the 9 Balboa Reservoir Project, also is shown on the above-mentioned map, and this companion 10 legislation is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 230137 and 11 incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, In Public Works ("PW") Order No. 207954, dated March 12, 2023, the 12 13 Interim Public Works Director certified that PW accepts the Proposed Street Names at their 14 approximate locations shown on the abovementioned map and that none of the Proposed 15 Street Names conflict with the names of existing streets located in the San Francisco; and WHEREAS, This PW Order also includes a report explaining the derivation of the 16 17 Proposed Street Names, and such PW Order, the street name map, and its report are on file 18 with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 230138 and incorporated herein by 19 reference; and

20 WHEREAS, For establishing the name of unnamed streets, San Francisco follows the 21 practices specified in Public Works Code, Section 423, the PW informational bulletin entitled 22 "Street Name Establishment/Street Name Change," and, despite California Streets and 23 Highways Code, Section 971, which allows the Board to name previously unnamed streets 24 without any hearing or notice, the Board has elected to proceed with a Resolution and a public

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hearing process to name the unnamed streets at this Project site in accordance with California
 Government Code 34091.1; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That consistent with law and procedures specified above, the Board of
Supervisors hereby establishes the official names for the listed unnamed Public Streets as
Diego Lane, Loquat Lane, Meyer Lane, and Wisteria Lane, in the approximate locations
shown on a map that is attached to the PW Order that is on file with the Clerk of the Board of
Supervisors; and, be it

8 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Proposed Street names will be operative at the time 9 the Board of Supervisors accepts the public dedication of the particular street segment or 10 segments; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That City departments are authorized to use the new street names prior to their operative date should it be necessary for efficient administration of governmental functions, such as permit issuance and creation of property tax bills; and, be it FURTHER RESOLVED, That by adopting this Resolution, the Board of Supervisors does not intend to effectuate any change in City department jurisdictional control over any portion of the streets depicted on maps on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors directs the Clerk of the Board to forward a certified copy of this Resolution to the County Surveyor in accordance with California Streets and Highways Code, Section 5026 in order to enter the names on the official records of San Francisco street names.

RECOMMENDING ADOPTION OF DIEGO LANE, LOQUAT LANE, MEYER LANE, AND WISTERIA LANE AS OFFICIAL STREET NAMES FOR YET TO BE CONSTRUCTED UNNAMED STREETS LOCATED WITHIN THE BALBOA RESERVOIR PROJECT.

BACKGROUND

On August 18, 2020, in Ordinance No. 142-20 (Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File No. 200423), the Board of Supervisors (the "Board" or "Board of Supervisors") approved a Development Agreement for the Balboa Reservoir Project (the "Project"), a mixed-income housing development of up to approximately 1,100 housing units, including approximately 550 units affordable to low- and moderate-income households, and approximately 4 acres of publicly accessible open spaces, among other uses.

The Project is located generally north of the Ocean Avenue commercial district, west of City College of San Francisco Ocean Campus, east of the Westwood Park neighborhood, and south of Archbishop Riordan High School.

Under the Development Agreement, Reservoir Community Partners (the "Project Sponsor") will construct and dedicate public streets within and adjacent to the Project area for residents of the Project, the community, and the public (collectively the "Public Streets").

The Board of Supervisors anticipates dedicating these Public Streets as an open public right-of-way through subsequent actions and accepting the Public Streets and attendant public infrastructure for City maintenance and liability purposes subject to certain conditions.

To avoid public confusion with street names and create a consistent and comprehensive street naming nomenclature applicable to this multi-year phased project, Public Works proposes that the Board of Supervisors officially name all Public Streets.

The proposed street names for the Public Streets ("Proposed Street Names") are, in alphabetical order: Diego Lane, Loquat Lane, Meyer Lane, and Wisteria Lane, and are shown in their approximate locations on <u>Attachment 1.</u> The Proposed Street Names are a result of an extensive conversation between the Project Sponsor and members of the community to create a cohesive structure and strategy around the naming process. This was followed by a community meeting on September 10th, 2022 at Unity Plaza adjacent to the Project, where attendees voted among a list of names, proposed several additional write-in options, and discussed their favorites. For community members who were not able to make the meeting, there was an online poll that was emailed to the community and included in local news sources, where community members could vote on their favorite name. After determining the most popular names, the Project Sponsor discussed the top names with the District 7 Supervisor and finalized the Proposed Street Names.

Proposed Street Names pay homage to the history of the neighborhood, while also embracing the future of the community. Diego Lane will connect Edwin M. Lee Avenue and Frida Kahlo Way, in the general vicinity of the proposed site of City College's new Diego Rivera Theater, the building that will also house Rivera's relocated Pan American Unity mural. The tree streets Wisteria Lane, Loquat Lane, and Meyer Lane, celebrate the vegetation with the future Balboa Reservoir Park.

Through a separate Public Works Order, the Interim Director of Public Works will recommend renaming the 300 block of existing Lee Avenue north of Ocean Avenue and naming a future extension of this street to "Mayor Edwin M. Lee Avenue 李孟賢市長街". This street extension also is associated with the Project. The street name change and street name establishment regarding "Mayor Edwin M. Lee Avenue 李孟賢市長街" is addressed in companion legislation before the Board of Supervisors.

The Department of Public Works ("Public Works") processes proposed street name establishment for unnamed streets pursuant to the requirements of the California Streets and Highways Code Section 971 and Public Works informational bulletin entitled "Street Name Establishment/Street Name Change." Public Works also follows additional procedures regarding street name establishment in accordance with Streets and Highways Code Section 423, the Proposed Street Names do not exist in our current list of official street names, and therefore, do not conflict or cause confusion with existing street names.

On March 12, 2023, Public Works recommended establishment of the Proposed Street Names by Public Works Order No. 207816. After execution, the proposed street name of "Edwin M. Lee Avenue" was updated to "Mayor Edwin M. Lee Avenue 李孟賢市長街".

This Public Works Order No. 207954, which includes Attachment 1, updates the proposed street name to "Mayor Edwin M. Lee Avenue 李孟賢市長街" and supersedes the previous Public Works Order No. 207816.

FINDINGS

The Interim Director of Public Works finds that the Proposed Street Names, as described above and as depicted on <u>Attachment 1</u> hereto, are consistent with the requirements of the applicable State laws and local laws and regulations pertaining to the adoption of names for unnamed streets, including specifically that the aforementioned Proposed Street Names do not conflict with the names of existing City streets.

DECISION


The Interim Director of Public Works hereby recommends that the Board of Supervisors establish the Proposed Street Names for the unnamed roadways as depicted on <u>Attachment 1</u> hereto, including by adopting legislation establishing the street names, and, in accordance with California Streets and Highways Code Section 5026, direct the Department to add the street names to the official records of San Francisco street names.
