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Ordinance authorizing settlement of the lawsuit filed by Esquivel Grading & Paving, Inc. against the City and County of San Francisco by the payment of \$250,000; the action against the City was filed on April 12, 2022, in the Superior Court of California, County of San Francisco, Case No. CGC-20-587321; entitled Con-Quest Contractors, Inc. v. Esquivel Grading & Paving, Inc., et al.; the lawsuit involves alleged breach of contract; material terms of the settlement are that the City will pay Con-Quest Contractors, Inc. \$250,000 and Esquivel will pay Con-Quest \$150,000.

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. Pursuant to Charter Section 6.102(5), the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the City Attorney to settle the action entitled Con-Quest Contractors, Inc. v. Esquivel Grading & Paving, Inc., et al., Superior Court of California, County of San Francisco, Case No. CGC-20-587321 by the payment of \$250,000 in exchange for Esquivel Grading & Paving, Inc. and Con-Quest Contractors, Inc. dismissing the lawsuit in its entirety with prejudice and releasing the City from certain claims. The lawsuit involves the alleged breach of San Francisco Public Works Contract No. 2267J[R], Columbus Avenue Pavement Renovation and Water Main Replacement Project. Under the terms of the settlement, (1) the City will pay Con-Quest \$250,000; (2) Esquivel will pay Con-Quest \$150,000; (3) Con-Quest and Esquivel will file a joint dismissal with prejudice of the lawsuit within 15 days of payment of the settlement sum; and (4) the parties agree to certain specified releases.

Section 2. The above-named action was filed in Superior Court of California, County of San Francisco, on April 12, 2022, and the following parties were named in the lawsuit: plaintiff Con-Quest Contractors, Inc.: defendant and cross-complainant Esquivel Grading &

Paving, Inc.; defendant Fidelity & Deposit Company; and cross-defendant City and County of San Francisco. /// /// ///
