8 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

9 Section 1. Pursuant to Charter Section 6.102(5), the Board of Supervisors hereby  
10 authorizes the City Attorney to settle the action entitled Justin Tsai v. City and County of San  
11 Francisco et al., San Francisco Superior Court, Case No. CPF-20-517295, by the payment of  
12 \$185,000. The lawsuit involves an employment dispute.
