3 **Resolution approving report of assessment costs submitted by the Director of Public**
4 **Works for inspection and/or repair of blighted properties ordered through the**
5 **Accelerated Sidewalk Abatement Program, ordered to be performed by said Director**
6 **pursuant to the provisions of Administrative Code, Chapter 80, the costs thereof**
7 **having been paid for out of a blight abatement fund.**

9 WHEREAS, Pursuant to the provisions of Administrative Code, Chapter 80, the
10 Director of Public Works did cause the correction of blighted conditions at various locations
11 where the obligation to perform such correction is that of the property owners; and

12 WHEREAS, The Director of Public Works considered objections to inspection fees and
13 sidewalk maintenance and repair activities pursuant to the provisions of Administrative Code,
14 Chapter 80; and

15 WHEREAS, By Public Works Order No. 207889, the Director of Public Works approved
16 a Report of Assessment Costs for inspection and/or repair of blighted properties ordered
17 through the Accelerated Sidewalk Abatement Program, the costs thereof having been paid for
18 by the City and County out of the Accelerated Sidewalk Abatement Program Blight Abatement
19 Fund; and

20 WHEREAS, On May 9, 2023, the Board of Supervisors held a duly-noticed public
21 hearing to consider the report of assessment costs; and

22 WHEREAS, Following the public hearing the Board of Supervisors made any
23 corrections, revisions, or modifications to the report as it deems necessary; now, therefore, be
24 it

1 RESOLVED, The Board does hereby confirm said Report of Assessment costs
2 described in Public Works Order No. 207889; and, be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution and a copy of said itemized
4 Report of Assessment Costs confirmed by the Board shall be transmitted to the Controller and
5 Tax Collector of the City and County, whereupon it shall be the duty of said officers to add the
6 amount of each assessment to the next regular bill for taxes levied against each respective
7 parcel of land, and thereafter each said amount shall be collected at the same time and in the
8 same manner as ordinary City and County taxes are collected, and shall be subject to the
9 same procedure under foreclosure and sale in case of delinquency as provided for ordinary
10 taxes of the City and County; and, be it

11 FURTHER RESOLVED, That all monies received in payment of the assessments shall
12 be credited to the Blight Abatement Fund provided for in the Administrative Code, Chapter 80.

REPORT TO THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS ON ASSESSMENT COSTS FOR INSPECTION FEES AND ABATEMENT ACTION ON BLIGHTED PROPERTIES AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS, AND TRANSMITTING RESOLUTION TO SAID BOARD CONFIRMING SAID REPORT.

PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 80 OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS DID CAUSE THE CORRECTION OF BLIGHTED SIDEWALK CONDITIONS AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS WHERE THE OBLIGATION TO PERFORM SUCH CORRECTION IS THAT OF THE PROPERTY OWNERS.

IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAPTER 80 OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, EACH OF THE ASSESSMENTS INCLUDES THE EXPENSE OF THE WORK THEREOF TO COVER THE COST OF CITY ADMINISTRATION.

THE OWNERS LISTED HAVE REQUESTED THE CITY TO PERFORM THE CORRECTION AND PLACE THE COST OF THE INSPECTION AND / OR WORK AS AN ASSESSMENT ON THEIR PROPERTY TAXES, OR HAVE OTHERWISE FAILED, REFUSED, OR NEGLECTED TO REIMBURSE THE CITY FOR THE COST OF THE INSPECTION AND / OR WORK. THEREFORE, IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT PURSUANT TO PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 80 OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, THAT THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS ATTACH THE ASSESSED COSTS ONTO THE PROPERTY TAX BILLS OF THE AFOREMENTIONED PROPERTIES.

ALSO PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 80 OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, PRIOR TO THE ATTACHMENT OF THE ASSESSED COSTS ONTO THE PROPERTY TAX BILLS OF THE AFOREMENTIONED LOCATIONS, THIS DEPARTMENT REQUESTS THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS SCHEDULE A HEARING TO REVIEW THIS REPORT, AND HEAR ANY OBJECTIONS WHICH MAY BE RAISED BY ANY PROPERTY OWNER LIABLE TO BE ASSESSED FOR THE EXPENSE DESCRIBED IN THIS REPORT.

Pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 80 of the Administrative Code, the property owner is responsible to correct blighted conditions, including the repair of the sidewalk area fronting the property. Upon notification by the City to correct the blighted condition, you as the property owner were invoiced a blight inspection fee, and / or have agreed to have the City perform the work, or did not make the needed repairs by the time specified. As a result, the City has repaired the sidewalks and invoiced you for the inspections and repairs.

As the invoice for the blight inspection fees and / or sidewalk repairs is still outstanding, either by agreement to have the cost of inspection and / or repairs placed as an assessment or by nonpayment of the invoice, you are hereby notified of a hearing before the Board of Supervisors to place these costs as an assessment on your property taxes. Please note that this process will incur an extra 12% of the amount of the unpaid invoice as an administrative fee.

Subject: Report of Assessment Costs for Sidewalk and Curb Repairs through the Public Works Accelerated Sidewalk Abatement Program

Dear Members of the Board:

The California State Highway Code Section 5611 and San Francisco Public Works Code Section 706 require property owners to maintain the sidewalk adjacent to their property. The Department of Public Works performs sidewalk inspections and notifies property owners of sidewalk defects that need to be repaired and for which they are responsible.

Although property owners are first notified of sidewalk defects for which they are responsible and are provided thirty (30) days within which to take action, if they do not timely address the identified deficiencies, a second inspection will be performed, and property owners will be referred to the Accelerated Sidewalk Abatement Program ("ASAP") and assessed inspection fees pursuant to Chapter 80 of the Administrative Code.

Under ASAP, property owners may elect to have City contractors perform the abatement work and have both the inspection fees and repair costs placed on their property tax.


Alternatively, if a property owner does not request City abatement and fails to repair the defects themselves, the City may repair the sidewalk and bill the property owner for inspection fees and the repair costs. If the property owner fails to pay the bill pursuant to the provisions of Administrative Code, Chapter 80, Public Works will submit an assessment for the outstanding amount to the Board of Supervisors for consideration to include in the next regular tax bill.

Enclosed for your review and approval are:

1. A list of properties that have either chosen to have the City perform repairs and have the costs placed on their property tax and/or property owners who have failed to reimburse the City for sidewalk inspection and repair fees.
2. A Resolution confirming the Order. Public Works communicated with property owners throughout the year to allow them the opportunity to dispute the area required for repair and associated costs prior to proceeding with repairs.
