18	County of San Francisco and Service Employees International Union. Local 1021, effective
19	July 1, 2023, to amend the compensation provision for 8238 Public Safety Communications
20	Dispatcher and 8239 Senior Police Communications Dispatcher to provide an additional sixth
21	salary step to both classifications.
