


FY2013-2022 Investment in OMI and Lakeview

In Fiscal Year 2021-2022,
DCYF invested \$164M in
more than 400 programs
for children, youth, TAY
and families across the

City.

DCYF's investment in the Lakeview, Oceanview, Merced Heights, and Ingleside communities increased from \$1.3 million in Fiscal Year 2013-2014 to nearly \$3.5 million in Fiscal Year 2022-2023.





Increase in funding for FY2021-22 and FY2022-23 is a result of short-term investments from the Summer Together Initiative and the Dream Keeper Initiative.

These initiatives helped us increase program funding for:

- Afterschool Enrichment
- Summer Programming
- Youth Workforce Development
- Mental Health Services



We believe that these funding amount is an underestimate of DCYF's total investment in Lakeview, Oceanview, Merced Heights, and Ingleside children, youth and families.

- Children and families may access DCYF-funded programs and services located outside of their home neighborhood
- Our public schools serve children and youth throughout the City not just in their neighborhood
