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

Overview

- Resolution approving Amendment No. 2 to the agreement between Conard House and DPH for behavioral health services.
 - Increase the agreement by \$47,437,236
 - Extend the term by four years and six months (total term of July 1, 2018, through December 31, 2027)
- Summary of Services:
 - Conard bridges residential treatment to permanent supportive housing
 - Outpatient mental health services and services to supportive housing residents who have chronic and severe mental health conditions.
 - Provide financial management services to help clients manage their public income benefits.




Fit into Overall System of Care

Conard House – Services

Conard Supportive Housing

- <u>Services</u>: provide transitional or permanent supportive housing services
- <u>Population Served</u>: people experiencing homelessness with mental illness. (503 clients/year)
- <u>Access</u>: clients are referred from residential treatment programs and other CBOs.

Conard Outpatient Services

- <u>Services</u>: mental health outpatient services – including case management and crisis services
- <u>Population Served</u>: clients living in Conard supportive housing. (255 clients/year)
- <u>Access</u>: clients are referred to outpatient services from Conard supportive housing providers.

Conard Rep Payee

- <u>Services</u>: help eligible clients establish and manage their public income benefits by providing representative payee and money management services
- <u>Population Served</u>: SF Mental Health System and HSA County Adult Assistance Program (CAAP). (692 clients/year)
- Access: BHS clinics, CAAP
