**Subject:** **File No. 230651.** Ordinance amending the Administrative Code to clarify when the filming of a news event does not require a use contract, to clarify that the Executive Director is appointed pursuant to Charter Sections 3.100(19) and 4.102(5), to authorize the Executive Director to approve the use of the Film SF logo by third parties to market Film Commission programs and activities, to increase the daily use fees to engage in film production, and to allow funds from the Film Rebate Project Account to be used to administer and market the Film Rebate Program.

If this legislation passes, the daily use fees for film companies seeking to engage in film production would increase. Still photography will increase from \$100 to \$200 a day, and commercial, corporate media, industrial media, video, or web video will increase from \$200 to \$300 a day. Production of a television series (each episode), web series (each episode), movie, pilot, short subject, or documentary with a budget of less than \$100,000 will increase from \$50 to \$100 a day; with a budget of \$100,000 to less than


\$500,000 will increase from \$100 to \$300 a day; and with a budget of \$500,000 or greater will increase from \$300 to \$500 a day.

Ordinance amending the Administrative Code to clarify when the filming of a news event does not require a use contract, to clarify that the Executive Director is appointed pursuant to Charter Sections 3.100(19) and 4.102(5), to authorize the Executive Director to approve the use of the Film SF logo by third parties to market Film Commission programs and activities, to increase the daily use fees to engage in film production, and to allow funds from the Film Rebate Project Account to be used to administer and market the Film Rebate Program. If this legislation passes, the daily use fees for film companies seeking to engage in film production would increase. Still photography will increase from \$100 to \$200 a day, and commercial, corporate media, industrial media, video, or web video will increase from \$200 to \$300 a day. Production of a television series (each episode), web series (each episode), movie, pilot, short subject, or documentary with a budget of less than \$100,000 will increase from \$50 to \$100 a day; with a budget of \$100,000 to less than \$500,000 will increase from \$100 to \$300 a day; and with a budget of \$500,000 or greater will increase from \$300 to \$500 a day.
