Transbay Program

- TJPA is the agency is charged with design, construction and operation of the Salesforce Transit Center and downtown rail extension.
- Replaced former Transbay Terminal with a multimodal Salesforce Transit Center.
- Creating a transit-oriented neighborhood featuring housing (35% affordable housing), open space, offices and shops.
- Extend Caltrain and California High Speed Rail service into downtown San Francisco through the Downtown Rail Extension project, also known as The Portal.

Interagency Cooperation Agreement

The agreement will outline TJPA-City cooperation and City services during implementation of the DTX project.

10 City departments will sign on to the single agreement. Department scopes of work and budgets will be revisited and updated annually to respond to the project needs over time.

- (2) City Consultation and Cooperation
- (3) Costs and Reimbursement
