10	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
11	Section 1. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by adding
12	Section 10.100-171, to read as follows:
13	SEC. 10.100-171. POLICE DEPARTMENT MODERNIZATION AND TRAINING FUND.
14	(a) Establishment of Fund. The Police Department Modernization and Training Fund is
15	hereby established as a category eight fund for the purpose of receiving all gifts of money that may be
16	offered to the City and County of San Francisco through the Police Department for the uses and
17	purposes described in subsection (b).
18	(b) Use and Administration of the Fund. Money comprising the Police Department
19	Modernization and Training Fund shall be used and expended to assist in modernizing the Police
20	Department's operations, administration, communications and technology, and to provide related
21	training to Police Department personnel. The Chief of Police, or the Chief's designee, is authorized to
22	administer the Police Department Modernization and Training Fund and to determine expenditures
23	from the fund for the uses and purposes described herein.

1	(c) Authority of Chief. The Chief of Police is authorized to accept all gifts to the Police
2	Department for the uses and purposes described in subsection (b), including but not limited to gifts of
3	money, equipment, property, supplies and services.
