5	filed on April 13, 2023; the claim involves allegations of property damage to the Hotel		
6	Whitcomb caused by shelter-in-place (SIP) hotel guests during the COVID-19 pandemic		
7	and resulting loss of use; other material terms of the settlement include a mutual full		
8	and final release, with each party to bear their own costs.

10	WHEREAS, 1231 Market Street Owner L.P. filed Government Code Claim No. 23-		
11	01978 on April 13, 2023, against the City and County of San Francisco (Claim); and		
12	WHEREAS, The Claim involves allegations of property damage to the Hotel Whitcomb

15	WHEREAS, The Human Services Agency has recommended settlement of the Claim
