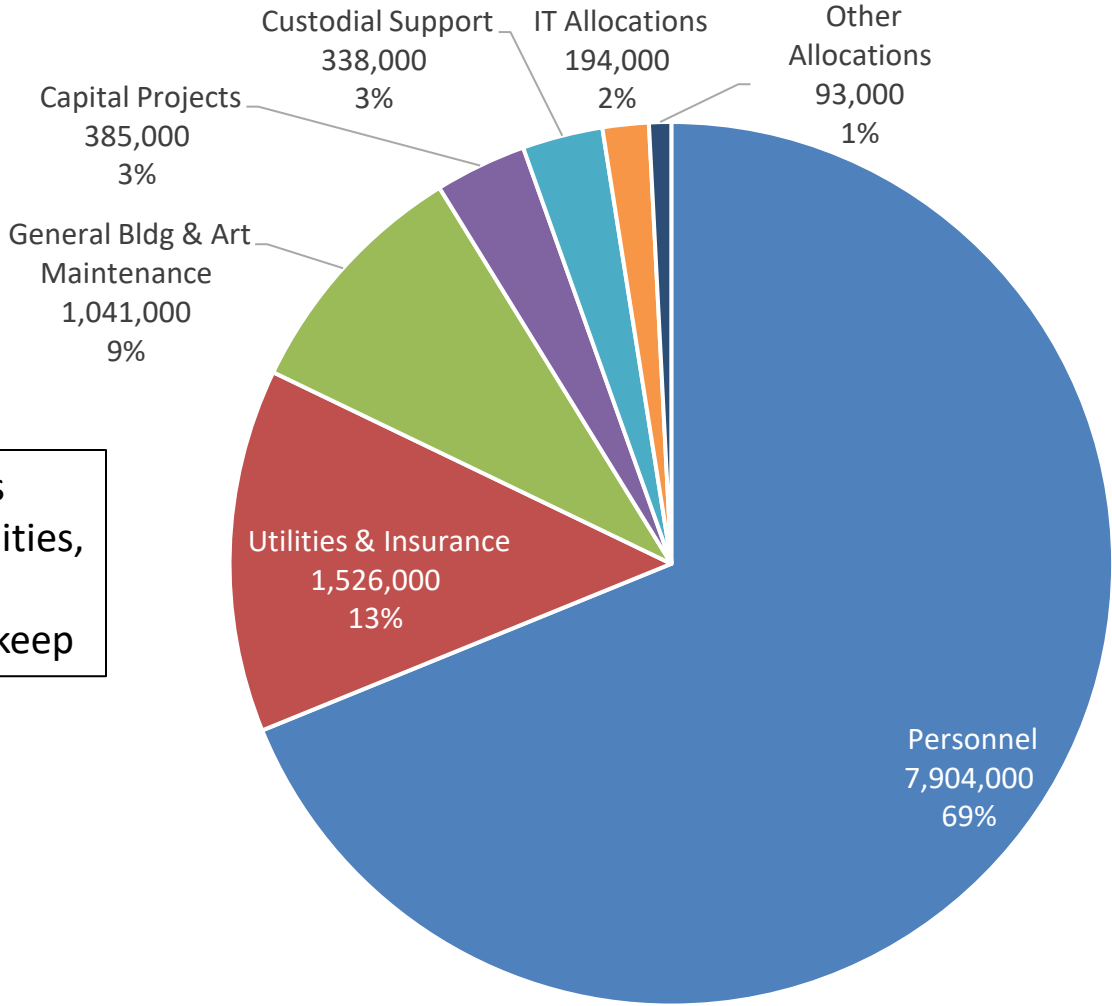

The City budget pays primarily for security, utilities, insurance and mechanical/building upkeep

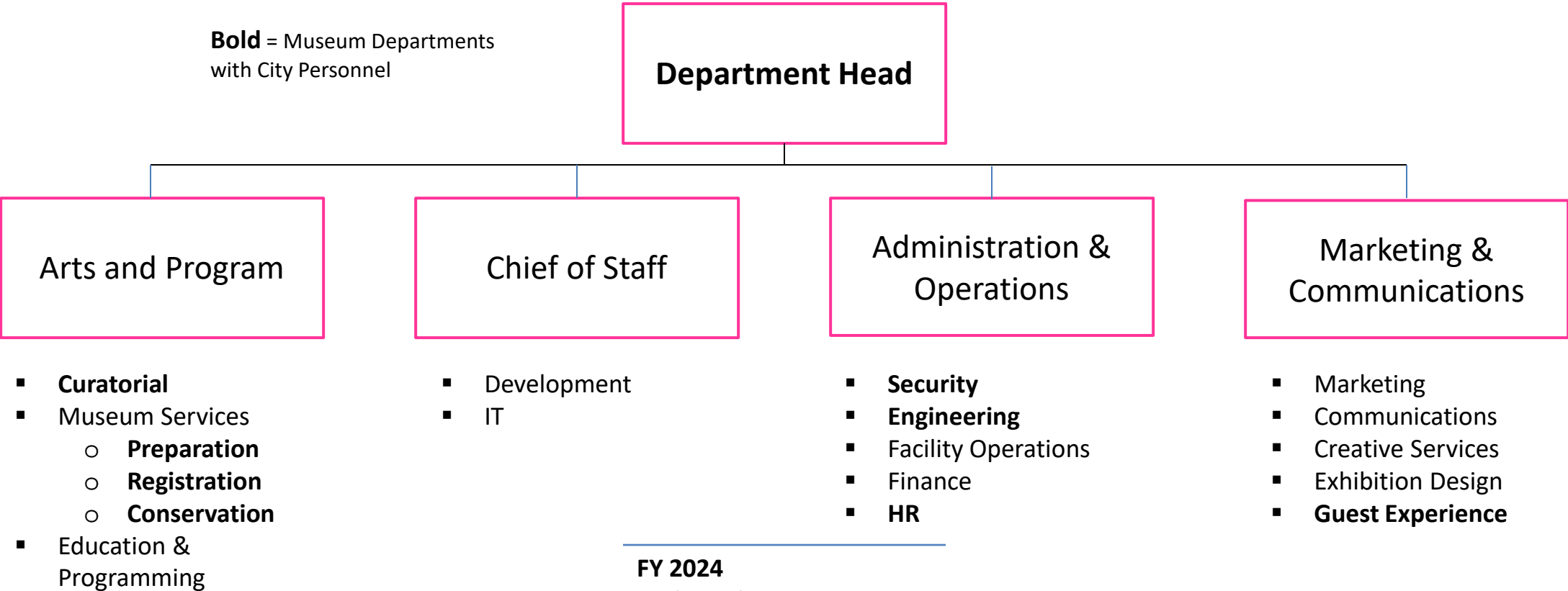

- To continue meeting budget requirements, 6 positions (5 security) will remain vacant, resulting in significant operational impacts
 - Operating hours were reduced from 6 to 5 days a week in past budget cycles due to insufficient security staffing
 - Periodic gallery closures due to insufficient security staffing, impacting attendance and visitor experience
 - 9,000 square feet of new gallery space opened July 2021 requires additional security
- General support for building maintenance, art conservation and other needs only covers life safety inspections, mechanical and security system maintenance, air filter replacements, sanitation clean-up, art storage, etc.
- Aging HVAC, boiler, fire sprinkler, security system, roof, etc. require more capital funding

Current Staffing and Vacancies

- Budgeted Staffing Levels have been reduced by 10% since FY 2019
- Freezing of 5 vacant security positions to meet budgetary reductions has resulted in reduction of public hours from 6 days to 5 days and minimal security coverage
- Freezing of Librarian position has limited public access and scholarly research
- All positions are permanent, except very small budget for temporary security officers and admissions attendants to fill temporary absences (e.g. sickness) or meet temporary art exhibition requirements
