11	Section 1. Findings.			
12	(a)	The Plannir	ng Department has determined that the actions contemplated in this	
13	ordinance comply with the California Environmental Quality Act (California Public Resources			
14	Code Section 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of the Board of			
15	Supervisors	in File No	and is incorporated herein by reference.	
16	(b)	These Plan	ning Code amendments will serve the public necessity, convenience,	
17	and welfare	for the reaso	ns set forth in Planning Commission Resolution No, and	
18	the Board incorporates those reasons herein by reference. A copy of Planning Commission			
19	Resolution I	No	is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No.

21	(c)	These Plan	ning Code amendments are consistent with the General Plan and the	
22	Priority Policies of Planning Code Section 101.1 for the reasons set forth in Planning			
23	Commission Resolution No, and the Board incorporates those reasons herein by			
24	reference.			

Section 2. The San Francisco Planning Code is hereby amended by amending Section
 608.14, to read as follows:

## SEC. 608.14. HISTORIC SIGNS IN HISTORIC SIGN DISTRICTS.

**Restoration and Maintenance.** Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 604(h) of 4 (a) ths Code, Ssigns which depict in text or graphic form a particular residential, business, cultural, 5 6 economic, recreational, or other valued resource which is deemed by the Planning 7 Commission to be of historic value and contributes to the visual identity and historic character 8 of a City neighborhood or the City as a whole shall be allowed to be restored, reconstructed, 9 maintained and technologically improved on a property by Conditional Use authorization of the Planning Commission provided that: (a) the proposed historic sign lies within an historic sign 10 11 district designated pursuant to Section 302 of the Planning Code and shown on the Zoning Map of the 12 *City and County of San Francisco; (b)* the historic sign to be restored, reconstructed or 13 technologically improved depicts a use, person, place, thing, cultural icon or other valued 14 character or characteristics of the City or a City neighborhood that, at the time of the historic sign authorization permit application, is at least 40 years old; (b) at least 50 percent of the area of 15 the sign remains legible, (c) the sign does not visually obstruct or significantly impair or detract 16 17 from, by glare or any other means, a City landmark or public vista; (d) the sign is not larger 18 than the sign that existed prior to the historic *authorization designation* of a sign that is proposed for restoration and does not appear to be more visually prominent than the sign that existed 19 20 prior to the historic *authorization designation*; and, (e) the sign is maintained in good condition, 21 repair and working order.

(b) Application for Historic Sign Authorization. Prior to the scheduling of the Conditional

- 23 <u>Use hearing before the Planning Commission required by subsection (a), the applicant for a historic</u>
- 24 sign authorization shall provide to the Department evidence in the form of photographs and/or
- 25 *documents demonstrating that:*

1	(1) the sign proposed for historic authorization is at least 40 years old; and			
2	(2) the sign depicts a particular residential, business, cultural, economic, recreational, or			
3	other valued resource of historic value and contributes to the visual identity and historic character of a			
4	<u>City neighborhood or the City as a whole.</u>			
5	(c) Application of Other Article 6 Requirements. Once a sign is authorized designated as			
6	historic under this Section, its is subject only to the requirements of this Section 608.14 and is exempt			
7	from all other provision of Article 6. However, any change of copy from the historic copy authorized by			
8	the Planning Commission or any enlargement, or alteration or shall be considered an abandonment			
9	of the historic sign authorization and the sign shall then be considered a new sign subject to all the			
10	provisions of this Article 6 shall be governed by the provisions of Section 178 of this Code. The			
11	addition of a frame to a painted wall sign shall not be considered an enlargement or alteration under			
12	this section.			
13	(d) <b>Referral to Historic Preservation Commission.</b> If the application for a historic sign			
14	authorization under this Section 608.14 is not otherwise required to be referred to the Historic			
15	Preservation Commission under the San Francisco Charter or this Code, it is not required to be			
16	referred. However, the Department may refer the application to that Commission for an advisory			
17	opinion.
