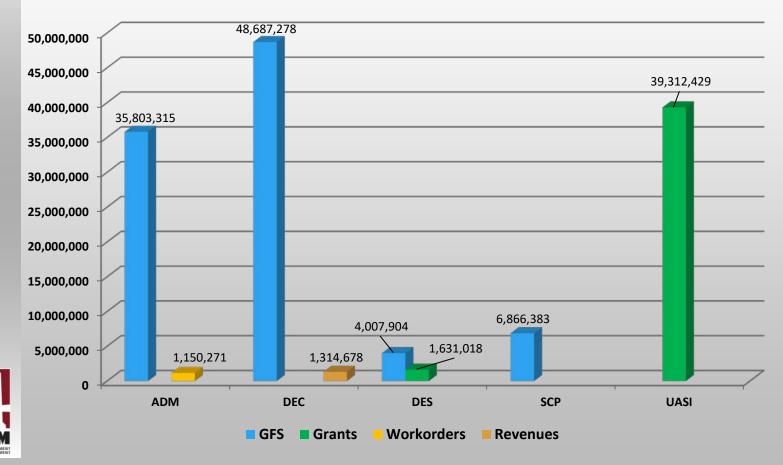

EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES AGENCY (EMSA)

Business and Tax Regulations, Health Codes - EMS Fees

- Continuing Fees
 - Updating fees to reflect amounts authorized under annual adjustment provisions
- Fees Related to New Services
 - Medical facilities that have been designated to receive ambulances and treat stroke trauma and pediatric patients
 - Event Medical Plans Fee schedule based on anticipated crowd size for permitted special events
