## PROSAC'S RESPONSE TO BOS FILE NO. 230482 PARK CODE – PROSAC MEMBERSHIP

WHEREAS, PROSAC members are concerned about Board of Supervisors File No. 230482, Park Code – PROSAC Membership, which proposes to 1) reduce the number of seats on the Parks, Recreation, and Open Space Advisory Committee (PROSAC), 2) provide for alternate members, 3) allow members to serve for more than four consecutive terms, 4) provide for the appointment of members having experience with environmental justice and disability issues; and 5) provide that meetings shall occur at City Hall; and

WHEREAS, PROSAC members, at their regular meeting of June 6, 2023, had their first opportunity to collectively discuss the ordinance that would significantly affect this longstanding citizens advisory body; now therefore be it

**RESOLVED**, That PROSAC urges the Rules Committee to continue BOS File No. 230482 until at least the end of July 2023; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED,** That PROSAC requests the sponsor of BOS File No. 230482 attends the July 11, 2023 regular meeting of PROSAC to share the purpose of the ordinance with the Committee, to have a dialogue with the Committee, and to understand the concerns of its members regarding this ordinance; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED,** That PROSAC is committed to working with the sponsor to craft amendments that would address all concerns brought about through this collaborative process.

The above resolution was proposed by Ken Maley (District 3) and approved at the PROSAC meeting held on June 6, 2023 with 12 members in support and 1 in opposition.
