Ordinance authorizing settlement of the lawsuit filed by Abdul Nevarez and Priscilla Nevarez against the City and County of San Francisco for \$227,500; the lawsuit was filed on September 27, 2019, in United States District Court, Northern District of California, Case No. 19-CV-06155-SK; entitled Abdul Nevarez and Priscilla Nevarez v. City of San Francisco, et al.; the lawsuit involves disability access violations in the City's golf courses; other material terms of the settlement are making certain disability access improvements at the Harding Park and Fleming Park golf courses.

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. Pursuant to Charter Section 6.102(5), the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the City Attorney to settle the action entitled <u>Abdul Nevarez and Priscilla Nevarez v. City of San Francisco, et al.</u>, United States District Court, Northern District of California, Case No. 19-CV-06155-SK by the payment of \$227,500 and making certain disability access improvements at the Harding Park and Fleming Park golf courses. The lawsuit involves allegations that all of the City's golf courses are inaccessible to individuals with disabilities.

Section 2. The above-named action was filed in United States District Court Northern District of California on September 27, 2019, and the following parties were named in the lawsuit: Plaintiffs Abdul Nevarez and Priscilla Nevarez and Defendant City and County of San Francisco.
