

Hi John, the Planning Department with direction of the Zoning Administrator Corey Teague, recommends approval for the proposed type 90 at 2565 Mission Street. The site is located within the Mission RUSD as defined in Planning Code Section 249.60. In this case the ZA has determined that the type 90 meets the intent of the Mission RUSD in that:

- the Type 90s can be approved for <u>existing entertainment establishments</u> that already have another license (Type 47, 48, etc.) without impacting their established land uses (i.e., Nighttime Entertainment, General Entertainment, Restaurant, Bar, etc.).
 - 2565 Mission Street has been operating with a type 47 on or before 01-NOV-1976, per the California ABC
 - The type 47 has been in continual use since then.
 - 2565 Mission Street has operated with an established land use of General Entertainment /
 Nighttime Entertainment. This operation has been operating prior to and continually since 1995.

Conversion of Type 47 ABC license to new Type-90 On-Sale General Music Venue License

Dear Ms. Cavillo:

This office represents Qualia Entertainment, Inc. dba Arena SF. My client has applied to the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) for an original Type-90 On-Sale General Music License. Currently Qualia Entertainment is operating a music /entertainment venue with a California ABC Type-47 license (Bonafide Eating Place license). The operation of the business under the proposed new license will remain identical.

A Type-90 ABC license is a new license (2023) that authorizes the sale of beer, wine, and distilled spirits at retail for consumption on the premises in a music entertainment facility, as defined in Business and Professions Code Section 23550. Sale, service, and consumption of alcoholic beverages are limited to the time period from 2 hours before a live performance until one hour after the live performance. Minors are allowed on the premises.

There are surrounding residences within 100 feet of my client's venue. Our establishment is in the middle of the Mission District and has been a music venue, restaurant, and bar for many years. It is well run and has served the community well for many years. With this new Type-90 license, if granted, my client intends to maintain his current operation with a slightly curtailed food operation.

The area is properly zoned [NCT-Mission Street Neighborhood Commercial Transit] for this type of ABC license. We do not see any problems with the San Francisco Police Department approving this new ABC license, with conditions. We have the support for this application from

many of our neighbors, and are open to the imposition of conditions, if necessary, to this license.

Arena SF is locally owned, and thus revenue and taxes from the business will stay in the community. This new license will allow Arena SF to sell its current ABC Type-47 license and use the proceeds on a complete remodel of the premises. This new license will allow the venue to remain open and viable, will sustain the pedestrian traffic to other businesses in the neighborhood, and keep more "eyes on the street" and make the neighborhood safer after 10 PM. Like many small businesses in San Francisco, the COVID-19 shutdown has been problematic for this venue.

Arena SF is part of the Arena Nightlife Group which owns music venues in San Francisco, Orange County, Los Angeles, and Mountain View. Arena SF has been well-managed and non-problematic since 2019. There have been no noise complaints and minimal police issues since the business opened four years ago. My client will continue with this new ABC music venue license to be respectful to the neighborhood and to its customers. Arena SF is committed to providing a welcoming atmosphere, top-notch music, and great service. Foremost, they will be Good Neighbors.

For the reasons outlined above, applicant Qualia Entertainment dba Arena SF respectfully requests that this letter be forwarded to the Public Safety & Neighborhood Services Committee of the Board and that this Committee and the full Board of Supervisors make a determination under California Business and Professions Code Section 23958.4 that the public need or convenience would be served by allowing this new ABC Type-90 liquor license to issue a this location.
