To Whom It May Concern:

The Planning Department recommends approval for ABC Type-21 license in conjunction with principally permitted Specialty Grocery Store use (d.b.a The Epicurean Trader) in the Upper Market Street Neighborhood Commercial Transit Zoning District per Planning Code Section 764. Planning Motion No. 19568 permitted the establishment of a Retail Sales and Service use on the ground floor of the Subject Property as a part of a Planned Unit Development. Moreover, Building Permit Application (BPA) No. 202212138181 established a change of use from 'General Retail Sales and Service' to 'Retail Grocery Store (Specialty)'.

Grocery Stores may provide beer, wine, and distilled spirits for consumption off the premises with a California Alcoholic Beverage Control Board License Type 21 (Off-Sale General) under the condition that all areas devoted to the display and sale of alcoholic beverages do not exceed 15% of the Occupied Floor Area of the establishment. The Subject Property must adhere to the conditions outlined in Planning Commission Motion No. 19568 and the following conditions of Planning Code Section 202.2(a)(1):

- 1. The business operator shall maintain the main entrance to the building and all sidewalks abutting the subject property in a clean and sanitary condition in compliance with the Department of Public Works Street and Sidewalk Maintenance Standards. In addition, the operator shall be responsible for daily monitoring of the sidewalk within a one-block radius of the subject business to maintain the sidewalk free of paper or other litter associated with the business during business hours, in accordance with Article 1, Section 34 of the San Francisco Police Code.
- 2. When located within an enclosed space, the premises shall be adequately soundproofed or insulated for noise and operated so that incidental noise shall not be audible beyond the premises or in other sections of the building, and fixed-source equipment noise shall not exceed the decibel levels specified in the San Francisco Noise Control Ordinance.
- 3. While it is inevitable that some low level of odor may be detectable to nearby residents and passersby, appropriate odor control equipment shall be installed in conformance with the approved plans and maintained to prevent any significant noxious or offensive odors from escaping the premises.
- 4. Garbage, recycling, and compost containers shall be kept within the premises and hidden from public view and placed outside only when being serviced by the disposal company. Trash shall be contained and disposed of pursuant to garbage and recycling receptacles guidelines set forth by the Department of Public Works.





Per BPA No. 202212138181, a Limited Restaurant was approved as an Accessory Use within the Specialty Grocery Store (d.b.a The Epicurean Trader). Limited Restaurants cannot provide alcohol for consumption on the premises with an ABC Type-41 license but may sell alcohol for consumption off the premises with a Type 20 or 21 License. In order to be eligible for a Type-41 alcohol license, the Accessory Use must be permitted as a Full-Service Restaurant and Bona-Fide Eating Place which have seating, and serve prepared, ready-to-eat cooked foods for consumption on the premises.
