Civil Grand Jury

County function managed by the Court

Staff the needs of the jury

Fiscal agent for jury's expenses

Budget: \$250K



Indigent Defense Administration

 IDA provides representation to the accused whenever the Public Defender cannot

■ Justice: all persons are innocent unless proven guilty

■ The accused are entitled to representation

Guaranteed right:

- U.S. Constitution, Amendment VI
- California Penal Code, Section 987

Budget: \$10.1M



Year Over Year Comparison

	2022-23	2023-24
Grand Jury	\$ 250,962	\$ 250,962
Indigent Defense	\$ 10,104,994	\$ 9,573,685
Total	\$ 10,305,956	\$ 9,824,647

Costs for attorneys providing indigent defense

2023-24 Reductions = \$381,309

- Mayor's Budget Office -\$306,309 reduction made to address citywide budget deficit
- Accepts BLA reduction of \$75,000



Pre-Trial Contracts

San Francisco Court has provided \$2M in contract funding to Pre-Trial for case managers and residential housing

- \$1.5M for supporting housing for 30 clients and 2 case managers
- \$500K for 5 case managers and operations
- Caseload Data (as of June 2023)
 - In Custody Referrals (ICR) = 128 clients
 - Assertive Case Management = 730 clients
 - OR Minimum Supervision = 189 clients
 - OR No Active Supervision = 559 clients
 - Diversion = 148 clients.



Pre-Trial Contracts

Key Program Elements:

- UpTrust new reminder app that is integrated with Court's calendaring system for appearance dates (*performance measure – is appearance rate higher for folks getting reminders vs. non Pre-Trial clients?*)
- A new CMS launching on July 1, 2023 that will track client data and performance measures (*objective: visual dashboard*)

Annual state funding for Pre-Trial Project is \$1.07M
