

Revenue Agreement - San Francisco Housing Authority: **50 Project-Based Vouchers at City Gardens**

Proposed Agreement Details

► Resolution: Approve the agreement between HSH and the San Francisco Housing Authority (SFHA) to use 50 project-based vouchers (PBVs) from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development at City Gardens.

Twenty-year term: June 15, 2023 through June 14, 2043

∽Amount: Anticipated **estimated revenue** to the City and County of San Francisco of \$50,000,000 or more.



Grant Agreement Overview

- Allocates 50 project-based vouchers (PBVs) to the family permanent supportive housing site at 333 12th Street (City Gardens)
 - Maximum number of units (25% at any site) that can be dedicated PBV units
 - Maximum term allowed (20-year term)
- **→**Allows the City to reallocate local Prop C dollars.
- ► Retroactive start date of June 15:
 - HUD requires signature within 60 days.



Program Context

- → April 2022: Board of Supervisors approved acquisition of City Gardens for \$147.5 million.
- ► July 2022: Homekey award for \$56.6 million for acquisition and operations.
- ► May 2023: Lease-up begins in May 2023
- ► Summer 2023: HSH and partners identify families to refer to the PBV units and work with them to complete SFHA application.
- October 2023: Anticipate lease-up complete.



City Gardens (333 12th Street).

Supportive Housing for Families

- 2,323 total units/slots of family housing
- Includes 979 units of site-based PSH, with 200 units at City Gardens
