# History

- 2017: Planning, OEWD, and Excelsior Action Group (EAG) began work on the Excelsior-Outer Mission Strategy
- Consisted of:
  - Open houses
  - Work groups
  - Workshops
  - Multi-lingual surveys
- Results of the Excelsior-Outer Mission Strategy showed that cleanliness and safety were ongoing needs of the commercial corridor and a potential step was to pursue CBD formation in the area
- 2019: Merchants, property owners, and stakeholders approached OEWD about forming CBD in area
- Multiple community and one-on-one meetings and intercept surveys were held for this process beginning in 2019
- Project was put on hold due to Covid-19 pandemic in 2020
- Resumed work in late 2021
  - 30% petition threshold reached to hold special balloting procedure in 2023




## Process

- 30% threshold is reached in March 2023
- Resolution of Intention submitted and goes through legislative process
  - Authorizes the special balloting procedure
- Ballots went out to rate payers (May 26, 2023)
- Special ballot procedure ends (July 11, 2023)
- Services will commence (1<sup>st</sup> Quarter of 2024)
