3	Resolution renaming a segment of Palo Alto Avenue to La Avanzada Street from its
4	new terminus at 241 Palo Alto Avenue westward to its intersection with Dellbrook
5	Avenue and renaming the remaining segment of Palo Alto Avenue between its

WHEREAS, Palo Alto Avenue, La Avanzada Street, and Dellbrook Avenue are located in the Clarendon Heights neighborhood and the immediate vicinity of Sutro Tower; and

WHEREAS, The street name for the segment of Palo Alto Avenue from its 250 block westward to its terminus at Clarendon Avenue has caused public confusion because maps of the area use the Palo Alto Avenue nomenclature but the City street signage does not show this name; and

WHEREAS, Some residents in the neighborhood refer to this portion of the officially designated Palo Alto Avenue, i.e., the area that would be the start of the 250 block, as La Avanzada Street because that is the private street name that starts at Sutro Tower and ends where it intersects with a portion of Palo Alto Avenue with no developed parcels; and

WHEREAS, Some residents in the neighborhood refer to the portion of the officially designated Palo Alto Avenue that is further west at the intersection of Dellbrook Avenue, i.e., the area that might be designated as the 300 block of Palo Alto Avenue or the 600 block of Dellbrook Avenue, as Dellbrook Avenue; and


WHEREAS, To avoid further confusion for neighbors, emergency providers, delivery services and other address-dependent functions, the Board of Supervisors proposes to harmonize the official street names with the neighborhood's informal street references and

1	existing street signage by officially changing the name of two segments of Palo Alto Avenue to
2	La Avanzada Street and Dellbrook Avenue, respectively, and terminating Palo Alto Avenue
3	after its last remaining address of 241 Palo Alto Avenue; and
4	WHEREAS, The location of the segments of Palo Alto Avenue to be officially renamed
5	to La Avanzada Street and Dellbrook Avenue, respectively, are shown on a map on file with
6	the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 230779 and incorporated herein by
7	reference; and
8	WHEREAS, For street name changes to existing streets, the City follows the applicable
9	practices specified in Public Works Code, Section 423, the Public Works informational bulletin
10	entitled "Street Name Establishment/Street Name Change," California Government Code,
11	Section 34091.1, and California Streets and Highways Code, Sections 970.5, and 5026; and
12	WHEREAS, In Public Works Order No. 208268 dated June 22, 2023, the Interim Public
13	Works Director certified that Public Works determined that renaming segments of Palo Alto
14	Avenue to La Avanzada Street and Dellbrook Avenue, respectively, does not conflict with the
15	names of existing streets located in the City as set forth in Public Works Code, Section 423;
16	and
17	WHEREAS, This Order also states that Public Works conducted the required notice to
18	adjacent property owners and provided a report on its findings concerning the street
19	renaming; and
20	WHEREAS, A copy of Public Works Order No. 208268, which includes the Public
21	Works report, is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 230779 and is
22	incorporated herein by reference; now, therefore, be it
23	RESOLVED, That consistent with the law and procedures specified above, the Board
24	of Supervisors hereby officially renames Palo Alto Avenue between the start of what would be

1	the 250 block of Palo Alto Avenue and its westward intersection with Dellbrook Avenue to La
2	Avanzada Street; and, be it
3	FURTHER RESOLVED, The Board officially renames the remaining segment of Palo
4	Alto Avenue between its intersection with Dellbrook Avenue and its westward terminus at
5	Clarendon Avenue to Dellbrook Avenue; and, be it
6	FURTHER RESOLVED, The Board acknowledges that the official terminus of Palo Alto
7	Avenue will be at its last known address of 241 Palo Alto Avenue; and, be it
8	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors acknowledges that Public
9	Works, on behalf of the City, properly posted the affected segments of Palo Alto Avenue that
10	are the subject of the street name change for the specified time period in compliance with
11	California Streets and Highways Code, Section 970.5; and, be it
12	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors, in accordance with
13	Transportation Code, Section 2.2, directs the Municipal Transportation Agency to prepare
14	and/or maintain street signs indicating the new official name of La Avanzada Street and
15	Dellbrook Avenue, respectively, along the street segment identified above; and, be it
16	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors directs the Municipal
17	Transportation Agency to ensure that any official signage on the public portion of La
18	Avanzada as identified in this legislation is clearly differentiated from private signage that may
19	be posted on the private portion of La Avanzada Street leading to Sutro Tower; and, be it
20	FURTHER RESOLVED, That by adopting this Resolution, the Board of Supervisors
21	does not intend to effectuate any change in City department jurisdictional control over any
22	portion of the streets depicted on the map on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors;
23	and, be it
24	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors directs the Clerk of the Board
25	to forward a certified copy of this Resolution to the County Surveyor in accordance with

1	California Streets and Highways Code, Section 5026 in order to enter the names on the

BACKGROUND:

At the request of Supervisor Melgar's Office, the City and County Surveyor performed an investigation into changing portions of the existing street name of Palo Alto Avenue, to Dellbrook Avenue and La Avanzada Street.

Palo Alto Avenue between Dellbrook Avenue and Clarendon Avenue will be renamed Dellbrook Avenue. This renaming will be an extension of the street name of Dellbrook Avenue.

Palo Alto Avenue between Dellbrook Avenue and at the end of the 241 block of Palo Alto Avenue, will be renamed to La Avanzada Street. This renaming will be an extension of the privately named street of La Avanzada Street.

As a result of the street name change, Palo Alto Avenue will reach its terminus at its last known address, 241 Palo Alto Avenue, and be it the intersection of La Avanzada Street.

FINDINGS:

- a) On March 22, 2023, City agencies were notified of the proposed name change Palo Alto Avenue. No objections were received from affected City agencies.
- b) On March 21, 2023, fronting property owners were notified of the proposed name change of Palo Alto Avenue. No objections were received from the two fronting property owners.
- c) Under Public Works Code Section 423, the proposed street names, does not conflict or cause confusion with existing street names as they are extensions of existing street names.
- d) The Interim Director of Public Works finds that the proposed street name, as described above, is consistent with the requirements of the California Streets and Highways Code and the Government Code, the Public Works Code, and the Public Works informational bulletin entitled "Street Name Establishment/Street Name Change" pertaining to the procedures for changing the name of existing streets. In addition, the Director specifically finds that the aforementioned proposed street name does not conflict with the names of existing streets located within the City.

DECISION:

The Interim Director of Public Works hereby recommends the following:

a) The street name of Palo Alto Aveneue between Clarendon Avenue and Dellbrook Avenue shall be renamed to Dellbrook Avenue, subject to Board of Supervisors approval.

- b) The street name of Palo Alto Aveneue between Dellbrook Avenue and its terminus at the intersection of Palo Alto Avenue and the private road named La Avanzada Street shall be renamed to La Avanzada Street, subject to Board of Supervisors approval.
- c) If the Board of Supervisors adopts this legislation, Public Works, in accordance with California Streets and Highways Code Section 5026, shall enter the street name on the official records of San Francisco street names.
