Motion authorizing preparation of written Proponent and Opponent ballot arguments and rebuttal ballot arguments for submittal to the voters at the June 7, 2011, Consolidated Special Election.

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors wishes to authorize the Board Member sponsors of the following ballot measures to prepare and submit a written proponent ballot argument and proponent rebuttal argument for submittal to the Director of Elections:

- Charter Amendment (Second Draft) to amend the Charter of the City and County of San Francisco by amending Section 8.100, to authorize the Board of Education to set the compensation for its members, not to exceed one-half the annual salary of a first-year teacher in the San Francisco Unified School District, and to establish training and professional development requirements for Board of Education members.

- Ordinance submitting to the voters amending the San Francisco Campaign and Governmental Conduct Code by amending Section 3.234 to allow an appointed former Mayor to obtain full-time City employment within one year after leaving office.
(Supervisor Chiu)

16 and opponent ballot argument and respective rebuttal ballot arguments on their measures;

18 FURTHER MOVED, That the sponsors and opponents of measures submitted to the

19 voters for the June 7, 2011, Consolidated Special Election, who are authorized by this motion

20 to prepare and submit arguments, may authorize or assign to any other person(s) under the

21 provisions of the San Francisco Elections Code Sections 530 and 550 (c) and (d) the right to

22 prepare and submit the proponent or opponent's ballot arguments and/or respective rebuttal
