11	WHEREAS, In 2018, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 129-18, which
12	established the LEATHER & LGBTQ Cultural District (the "District"); and
13	WHEREAS, This Resolution is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File
14	No. 171019 and incorporated herein by reference; and
15	WHEREAS, During the summer of 2023, supporters of the LEATHER & LGBTQ
16	Cultural District installed 107 Leather Pride Flag images on light poles in the District as part of
17	its ongoing placemaking efforts to reinforce the aesthetic and the identity of the neighborhood;

19	WHEREAS, During the summer of 2023, supporters of the LEATHER & LGBTQ
