2 Condemning Antisemitic, Anti-Palestinian, and Islamophobic Rhetoric and Attacks]

3 **Resolution calling for a sustained ceasefire in Gaza, humanitarian aid, release of**  
4 **hostages, and condemning antisemitic, anti-Palestinian, and Islamophobic rhetoric and**  
5 **attacks.**

7 RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors calls for a sustained  
8 ceasefire, provision of life-saving humanitarian aid in Gaza, and the release of all hostages;  
9 and, be it

10 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors urges the Biden  
11 Administration and Congress to call for a ceasefire, humanitarian aid, and the release of all  
12 hostages; and, be it

13 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors condemns  
14 Antisemitic, anti-Palestinian, Islamophobic, and xenophobic rhetoric and attacks; and, be it

15 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors condemns  
16 Hamas's attack on Israeli civilians, resulting in the deaths of at least 1,200 Israeli people on  
17 October 7, 2023; and, be it

18 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors condemns the  
19 Netanyahu government's attacks resulting in the deaths of tens of thousands of Palestinian  
20 civilians in Gaza; and, be it

1           FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors believes that a  
2 just and lasting peace between the Palestinian and Israeli people requires new leadership on  
3 both sides with a willingness and commitment to negotiate in good faith; and, be it

4           FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors urges the  
5 international community to work with Palestinian and Israeli people to find a just and lasting  
6 peace, and to conduct a full investigation of the conduct of all parties in this conflict and hold  
7 all parties and individuals who have overseen or engaged in war crimes and international  
8 human rights violations – including but not limited to gender based violence and killing of  
9 children – accountable.
