3	Resolution authorizing the City and County of San Francisco, acting by and through

Resolution authorizing the City and County of San Francisco, acting by and through the Mayor's Office of Housing and Community Development (MOHCD), to submit an application to and participate in the Prohousing Designation Program administered by the California Department of Housing and Community Development.

WHEREAS, California Government Code, Section 65589.9 established the Prohousing Designation Program ("PDP" or "Program"), which creates incentives for jurisdictions that are compliant with state housing element requirements and that have enacted local policies that are defined as "Prohousing" under said Section 65589.9; and

WHEREAS, The California Department of Housing and Community Development ("Department") has adopted regulations (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 25, § 6600 et seq.) to implement the Program ("Program Regulations"), as authorized by Government Code, Section 65589.9, subdivision (d) and approved as of January 2, 2024; and

WHEREAS, Local jurisdictions that are eligible under California Government Code, Section 65589.9 and the Program Regulations will be designated by the Department as Prohousing ("Prohousing Designation"), and, as such, will receive additional points or other preference during the scoring of their competitive applications for specified housing and infrastructure funding; and

WHEREAS, Under Section 6604(d) of the Program Regulations, the Department shall reject a Prohousing Designation application if the Department discovers that the applicant is engaging in certain activities, including "enacting laws, developing policies, or taking other actions that are reasonably likely to inhibit or constrain housing production, or that can be objectively shown to have inhibited or constrained housing production, including, but not

1	limited to, moratoriums on development; local voter approval requirements related to housing
2	production" or violating any applicable state housing laws; and
3	WHEREAS, The City has adopted a Housing Element that complies with California
4	Government Code, Section 65585(h); and
5	WHEREAS, The City is in compliance with applicable state housing laws; and
6	WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco, acting by and through the Mayor's
7	Office of Housing and Community Development ("City"), desires to submit to the Department
8	an application for a Prohousing Designation on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors
9	in File No. 240269 ("Application"); now, therefore, be it
10	RESOLVED, That City is hereby authorized and directed to submit an Application to
11	the Department, and the Director of the Mayor's Office of Housing and Community
12	Development (or designee) is authorized to execute and deliver the Application and, if the
13	Application is approved, the Program Documents (defined below) on behalf of the City for
14	participation in the Program; and, be it
15	FURTHER RESOLVED, That City is currently in compliance with applicable state
16	housing laws; and, be it
17	FURTHER RESOLVED, That City shall continue to comply with applicable state
18	housing laws and refrain from enacting laws, developing policies, or taking other local
19	governmental actions that would not comply with state housing laws; and, be it
20	FURTHER RESOLVED, That City acknowledges that, under Section 6604(d)(1) of the
21	Program Regulations, enacting laws, developing policies, or taking other local governmental
22	actions that are reasonably likely to inhibit or constrain housing production may disqualify the
23	City from the Program and a Prohousing Designation, and that examples of such local laws,

policies, and actions include moratoriums on development; local voter approval requirements

1	related to housing production; downzoning; and unduly restrictive or onerous zoning
2	regulations, development standards, or permit procedures; and, be it
3	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Prohousing Policies in the Application comply with
4	City's duty to affirmatively furthering fair housing pursuant to California Government Code,
5	Section 8899.50 and 65583; and, be it
6	FURTHER RESOLVED, That City confirms that its General Plan is in alignment with an
7	adopted sustainable communities strategy pursuant to Public Resources, Code
8	Section 21155- 21155.4; and, be it
9	FURTHER RESOLVED, That City confirms that its policies for the treatment of
10	homeless encampments on public property comply with and will continue to comply with the
11	Constitution and that it has enacted best practices in its jurisdiction that are consistent with the
12	United States Interagency Council on Homelessness' "7 Principles for Addressing
13	Encampments" (June 17, 2022, update); and, be it
14	FURTHER RESOLVED, That if the Application is approved by Department, the
15	Director of MOHCD is hereby authorized on behalf of the City to enter into, execute, and
16	deliver all documents required or deemed necessary or appropriate to participate in the
17	Program, and all amendments thereto (the "Program Documents"); and, be it
18	FURTHER RESOLVED, That City acknowledges and agrees that it shall be subject to
19	the Application, the terms and conditions specified in the Program Documents, the Program
20	Regulations, and any and all other applicable law; and, be it
21	FURTHER RESOLVED, That within thirty (30) days of the agreement being fully
22	executed by MOHCD and the Department, MOHCD shall provide the final agreement to the
23	Clerk of the Board for inclusion into the official file.
