>>San Francisco Shines With New Museums, Restaurants and Parks

“.....While undoubtedly challenging, the past two years have had a silver lining: Outdoor dining and drinking cropped up everywhere, from long-established restaurants like Nopa to brand-new spots like ***Casements***, a modern Irish bar in the Mission that opened in January 2020. The bar had originally planned to be a cozy, indoor-only affair, but instead it now serves stellar cocktails on **one of the best patios in the city.....**”

- Our hours of operation were cut by 28 hours
- Since the imposition of the curfew at the January hearing Casements has been operating at a loss

- We are requesting for 9 of those hours to be restored
 - Those 9 hours would be the difference between this small business being profitable and and us operating at a loss.

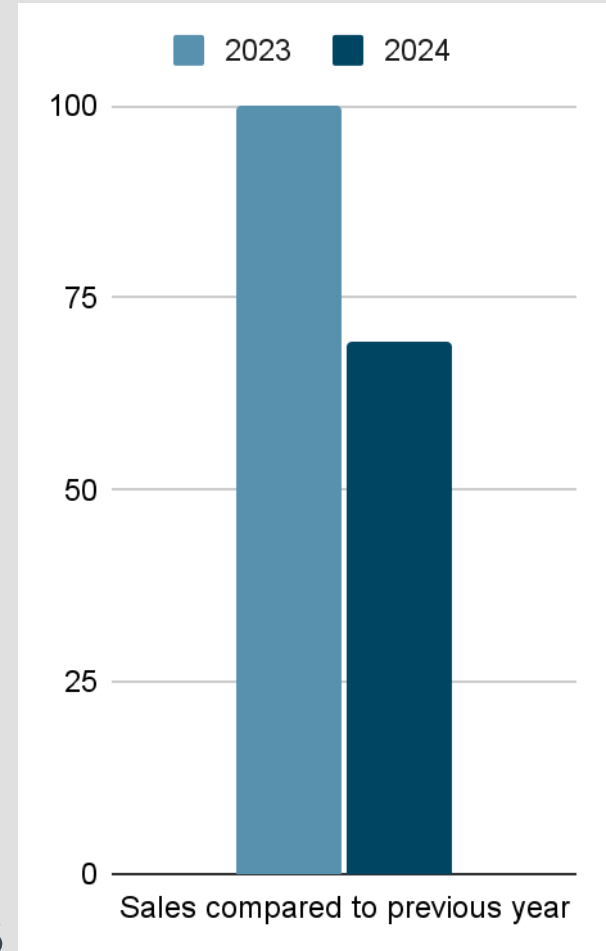

- 30.63% reduction in sales after 10pm.

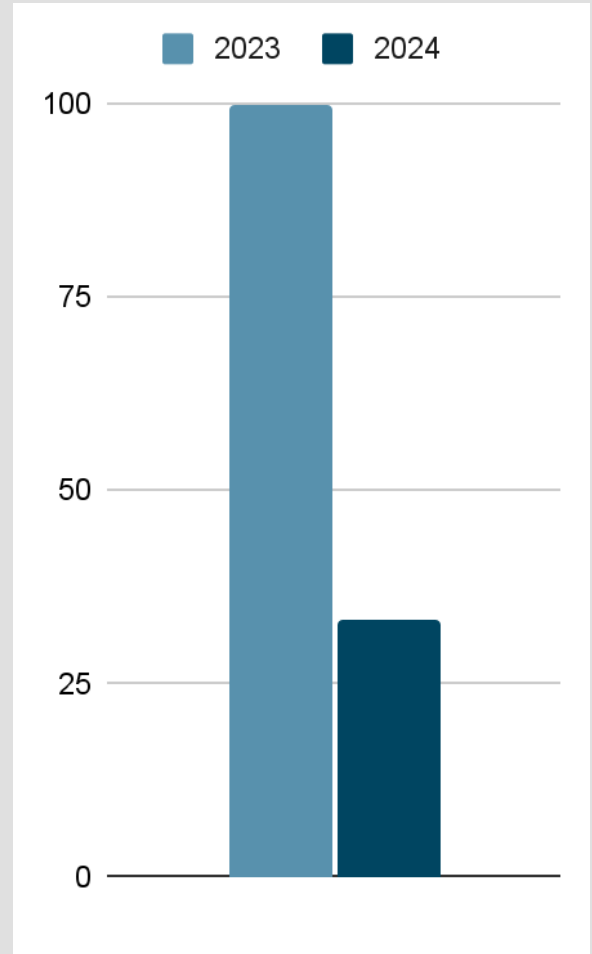

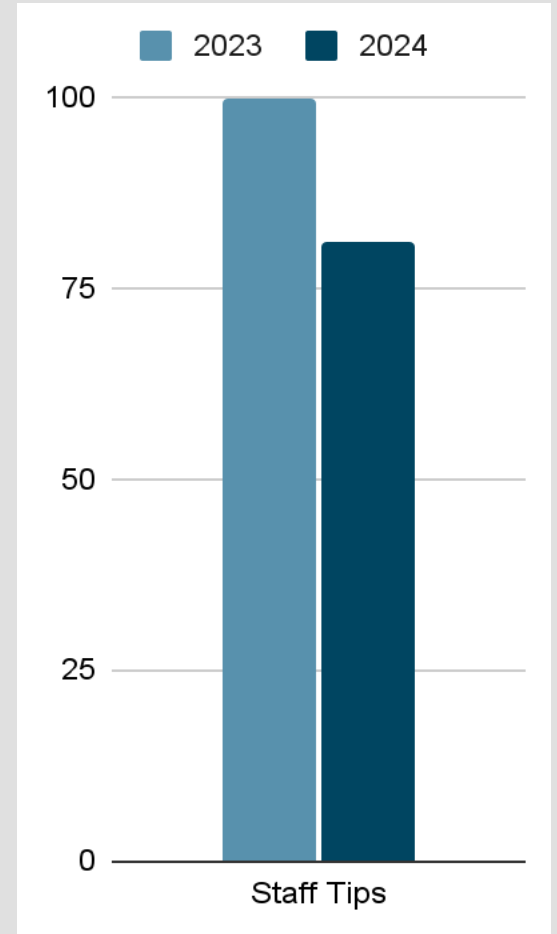

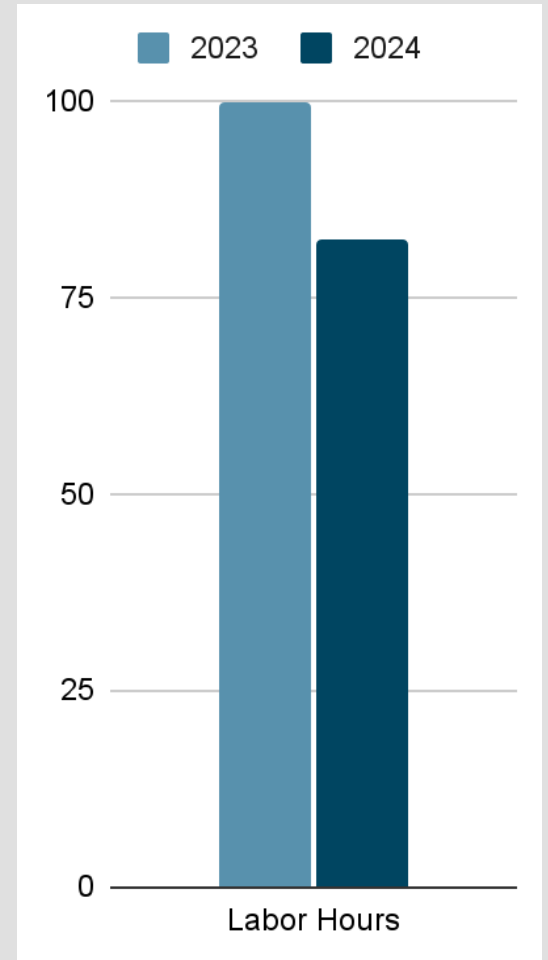

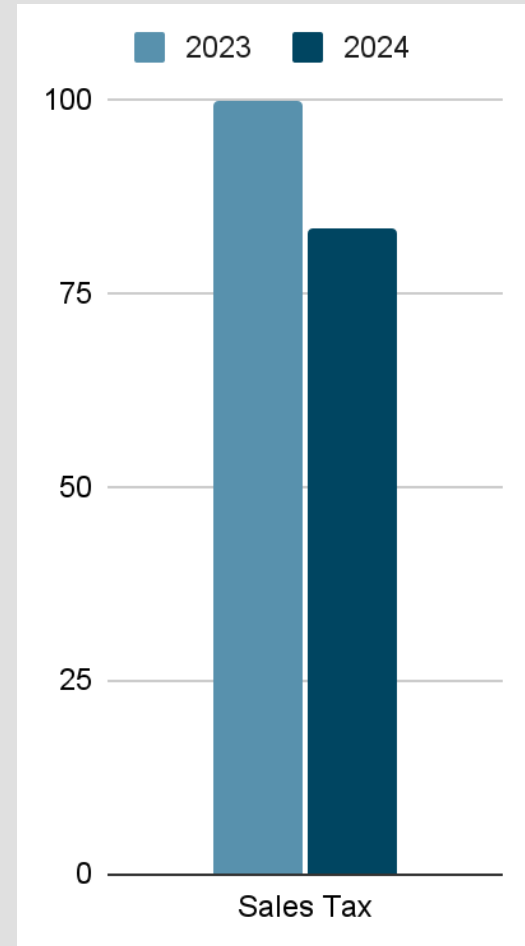


Impact of the Curfew

- 16.49% reduction is Sales Tax.

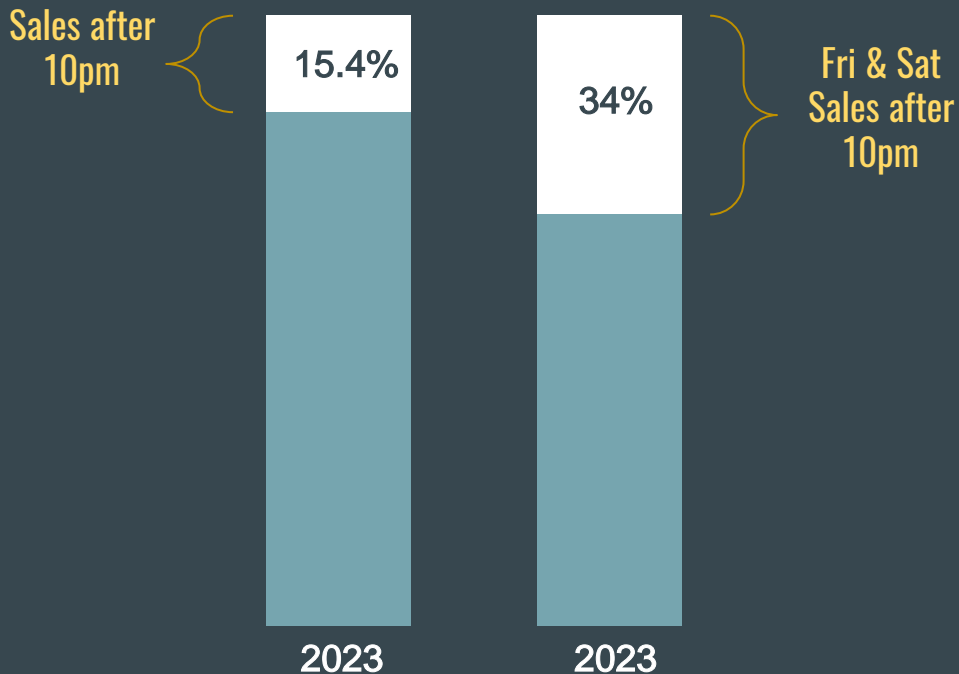

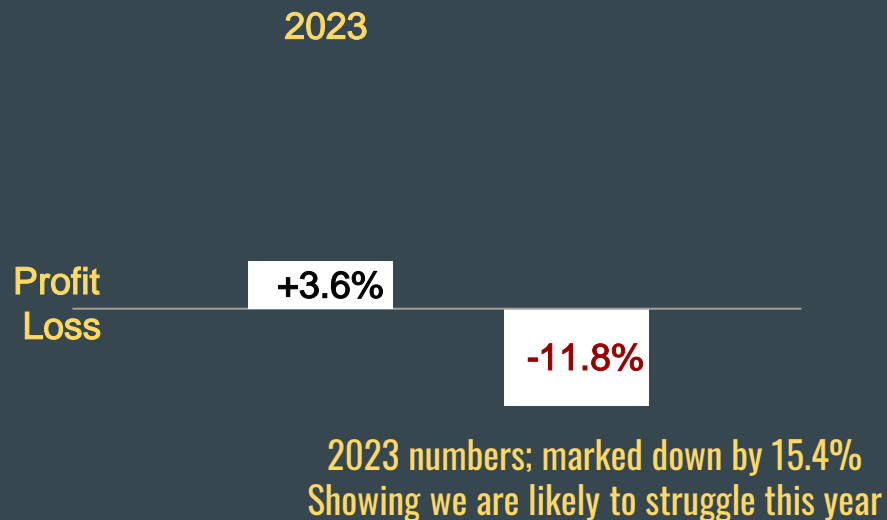
In 2023 15.4% of sales at Casements came after 10 pm.

2023

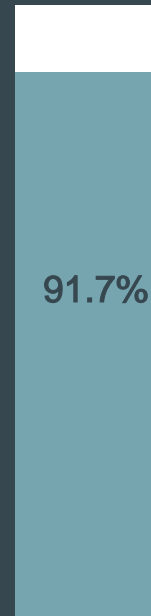
A 15.4% reduction in sales in 2023 would have meant Casements would have lost money, and our future as a business would be uncertain.

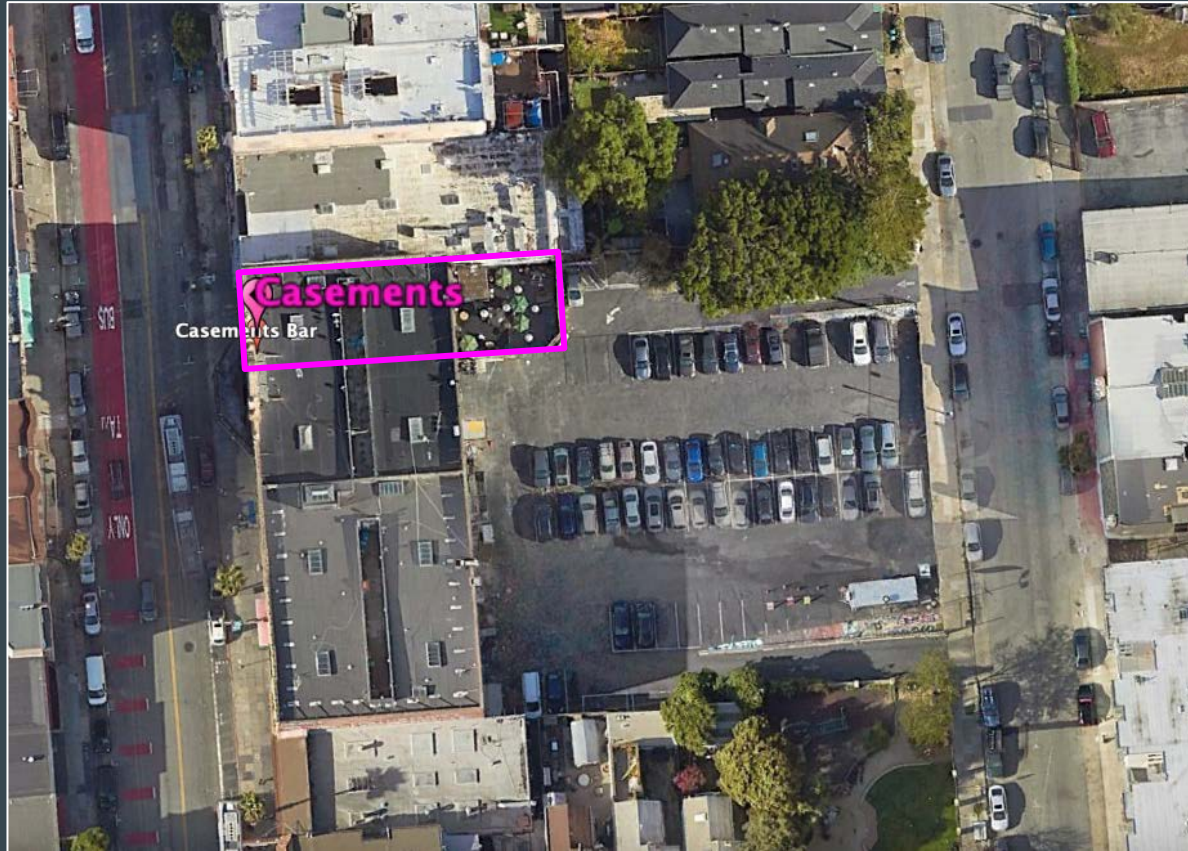
