

1 [Accept and Expend Grant - Retroactive - Centers for Disease Control and Prevention -
2 Targeted HIV/TB Strategic Information Technical Assistance for President’s Emergency Plan
3 for AIDS Relief and Global Fund - \$107,707]

4 **Resolution retroactively authorizing the Department of Public Health to accept and**
5 **expend a grant increase in the amount of \$18,016 from the Centers for Disease Control**
6 **and Prevention through The Regents of the University of California, San Francisco for a**
7 **total amount of \$107,707 for participation in a program, entitled “Targeted HIV/TB**
8 **Strategic Information Technical Assistance for President’s Emergency Plan for AIDS**
9 **Relief (PEPFAR) and Global Fund to Fight AIDS, Tuberculosis and Malaria (GFATM)**
10 **Countries,” for the period of September 30, 2023, through September 29, 2024.**

12 WHEREAS, The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), through The
13 Regents of the University of California, San Francisco (UCSF) as a pass-through entity, has
14 agreed to fund the Department of Public Health (DPH) in the amount of \$107,707 for
15 participation in a program, entitled “Targeted Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV)/
16 Tuberculosis (TB) Strategic Information Technical Assistance for President’s Emergency Plan
17 for AIDS Relief (PEPFAR) and Global Fund to Fight AIDS, Tuberculosis and Malaria (GFATM)
18 Countries,” for the period of October 1, 2019, through September 29, 2024; and

19 WHEREAS, Men Who Have Sex with Men (MSM) are the population most affected by
20 HIV in the United States, accounting for over two-thirds of all new HIV diagnoses; and

21 WHEREAS, Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP) has demonstrated high levels of efficacy
22 for HIV prevention among MSM; and

23 WHEREAS, A pharmacy-led model of PrEP delivery, combined with mobile app-based
24 PrEP support, could address many of the challenges with starting and staying on PrEP, and
25 also greatly reduce burden on the medical system; and

1 WHEREAS, An Annual Salary Ordinance Amendment is not required; and

2 WHEREAS, A grant increase of \$18,016 from \$89,691 was approved for the period of
3 September 30, 2023, through September 29, 2024; and

4 WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because DPH received
5 the award agreement on January 24, 2024, for a project start date of September 30, 2023;
6 and

7 WHEREAS, The grant budget includes a provision for indirect costs in the amount of
8 \$13,176; now, therefore, be it

9 RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend a grant
10 in the amount of \$107,707 from the CDC through UCSF; and, be it

11 FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and
12 expend the grant funds pursuant to Administrative Code, Section 10.170-1; and, be it

13 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
14 Agreement on behalf of the City.
