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Good afternoon, Brent:

Regarding retroactivity of Board File No. 240672 - At the time of initial approval in 2014, Airport Staff, in consultation with the City Attorney's Office, structured approvals of the program as separate four and five-year authorization periods and did not anticipate the term of the Agreement would exceed 10 years. SFO would like to retain the ability to use CBP's expanded services, which are anticipated to become more necessary and desirable for the busy summer travel season and beyond. Because the Agreement will exceed 10 years and since it has no defined term, we are bringing the item before the Board of Supervisors with retroactive approval back to the start of the program to resolve any uncertainty.
