15	Section 1. Chapter 21H of the Administrative Code is hereby amended by revising	
16	Section 21H.6, to read as follows. Section 21H.4 is reproduced below solely for informational	
17	purposes.	
18	SEC. 21H.4. MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS.	
19	In order for a Supplier to be awarded a contract, the Purchaser must determine that	
20	the Supplier meets the following minimum qualification requirements:	
21	(a) Compliance with all federal, state, and local laws and regulations applicable to	
22	retail dealers and manufacturers of firearms and ammunition; possession of valid federal,	
23	state and local firearms licenses, permits, and certifications required by all applicable	
24	jurisdictions in order to deal in firearms, including but not limited to, for California Suppliers,

1	valid State Board of Equalization seller's permit(s) and a Certificate of Eligibility pursuant to		
2	Section 26710 of the California Penal Code.		
3	(b) Public safety policies that serve the following purposes:		
4	(1) Prevention, detection, and screening for the transfer of firearms or ammunition		
5	to straw buyers or firearm traffickers.		
6	(2) Prevention of sales to prohibited individuals and persons too dangerous to		
7	possess firearms.		
8	(3) Protection against the theft of firearms and ammunition.		
9	(4) Employee training designed to ensure maximum compliance with the law.		
10	(5) Assistance to law enforcement in the investigation and prevention of criminal		
11	access to guns.		
12	(c) No unresolved ATF violations within the last five years;		
13	(d) An average of no more than five trace requests from the ATF per year over the		
14	prior five years; and		
15	(e) Five or fewer thefts of firearms and/or ammunition from its facilities over the prior		
16	five years.		
17	SEC. 21H.6. EXCEPTIONS.		
18	The requirements of Section 21H.4 shall not apply in the following circumstances:		
19	(a) The City is procuring firearms or ammunition under Administrative Code Section		
20	21.15.		
21	(b) <u>Through June 24, 2025</u> , <u>Tt</u> he City <u>is procuring may purchase</u> firearms or ammunition		
22	from a Supplier from whom it previously <i>procured purchased</i> such goods within the 24 months		
23	prior to <u>June 24, 2024.the effective date of the ordinance establishing this Chapter 21H, in Board File</u>

1	Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after
2	enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the
3	ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board
4	of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.
5	
6	Section 3. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors
7	intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles,
8	numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal
9	Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment
10	additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears under
11	the official title of the ordinance.

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LEGISLATIVE DIGEST

[Administrative Code - Firearms and Ammunition Procurement Policy]

Ordinance amending the Administrative Code to set an end date of June 24, 2025, to the time period within which, without complying with the firearms and ammunition procurement requirements of Administrative Code, Section 21H.4, the City may purchase firearms and ammunition from a supplier from whom it had, within the 24 months prior to June 24, 2024, purchased such goods.

Existing Law

Administrative Code Section 21H.4 sets forth minimum qualifications for suppliers to the City of firearms and ammunition. Section 21H.6(b) exempts from the requirements of 21H.4 purchases of firearms and ammunition from suppliers from whom the City purchased such goods within the 24 months prior to the effective date of Administrative Code Chapter 21H, which is June 24, 2024.

Amendments to Current Law

This ordinance would amend Section 21H.6(b) to limit the time period within which that exception applies, such that the exception would cease to apply after June 24, 2025.
