4 **Motion appointing Henry Karnilowicz, Misha Olivas, Raquel Redondiez, Norman Lynde,**  
5 **Tanya Reyes, Christian Martin (residency requirement waived), and Janetta Johnson,**  
6 **terms ending December 1, 2027, to the SOMA Community Stabilization Fund**  
7 **Community Advisory Committee.**

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9 MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does  
10 hereby appoint the hereinafter designated persons to serve as members of the SOMA  
11 Community Stabilization Fund Community Advisory Committee pursuant to the provisions of  
12 Administrative Code, Chapter 5, Article XXVII, for the terms specified:

13 Henry Karnilowicz, seat 1, succeeding John Elberling, term expired, must meet one or  
14 more of the requirements listed in Administrative Code, Chapter 5, Article XXVII, Section 5.27-  
15 2, for the unexpired portion of a four-year term ending December 1, 2027;

16 Misha Olivas, seat 2, succeeding themselves, term expired, must meet one or more of the  
17 requirements listed in Administrative Code, Chapter 5, Article XXVII, Section 5.27-2, for the  
18 unexpired portion of a four-year term ending December 1, 2027;

19 Raquel Redondiez, seat 3, succeeding themselves, term expired, must meet one or more  
20 of the requirements listed in Administrative Code, Chapter 5, Article XXVII, Section 5.27-2, for  
21 the unexpired portion of a four-year term ending December 1, 2027;

22 Norman Lynde, seat 4, succeeding themselves, term expired, must meet one or more of  
23 the requirements listed in Administrative Code, Chapter 5, Article XXVII, Section 5.27-2, for  
24 the unexpired portion of a four-year term ending December 1, 2027;

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1 Tanya Reyes, seat 5, succeeding Adan Mesnick, term expired, must meet one or more  
2 of the requirements listed in Administrative Code, Chapter 5, Article XXVII, Section 5.27-2, for  
3 the unexpired portion of a four-year term ending December 1, 2027;

4 Christian Martin (residency requirement waived), Seat 6, succeeding themselves, term  
5 expired, must meet one or more of the requirements listed in Administrative Code, Chapter 5,  
6 Article XXVII, Section 5.27-2, for the unexpired portion of a four-year term ending December  
7 1, 2027;

8 Janetta Johnson, seat 7, succeeding themselves, term expired, must meet one or more of  
9 the requirements listed in Administrative Code, Chapter 5, Article XXVII, Section 5.27-2, for  
10 the unexpired portion of a four-year term ending December 1, 2027; and, be it

11 FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

- 12 1. The membership of the SOMA Community Stabilization Fund Community Advisory  
13 Committee has a goal to be representative of the diversity of the City and County of  
14 San Francisco.
- 15 2. Applicant Christian Martin, who is not a resident of San Francisco, is a person with  
16 experience that uniquely qualifies them to serve on the SOMA Community Stabilization  
17 Fund Community Advisory Committee.
- 18 3. The SOMA Community Stabilization Fund Community Advisory Committee has  
19 attempted to fill the position, for which Christian Martin was nominated, with an  
20 individual who is City a resident and who has the specific experience, skills, and  
21 qualifications, but has been unable to do so at this time. The Rules Committee has  
22 certified that Christian Martin is qualified to serve on the SOMA Community  
23 Stabilization Fund Community Advisory Committee.
- 24 4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there is no  
25 other possible representatives who is a resident of San Francisco, who has the specific

1 experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by this applicant, and who is willing to  
2 serve on the SOMA Community Stabilization Fund Community Advisory Committee at  
3 this time; and, be it

4 FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency requirement  
5 for Christian Martin, as is allowed in cases where no qualified City resident who is willing to  
6 serve can be found, pursuant to Charter, Section 4.101(b), that otherwise requires person(s)  
7 appointed to boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative act of the  
8 Board of Supervisors to be resident(s) of the City and County of San Francisco.

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
