

1 [Contract Amendment - En Pointe Technology Sales Inc. - Not to Exceed \$28,000,000]

2 **Resolution authorizing the Office of Contract Administration to enter into the First**  
3 **Amendment between the City and En Pointe Technology Sales, Inc. (En Pointe, part**  
4 **of the Technology Store procurement vehicle), in which the amendment shall**  
5 **increase the contract amount from \$24,000,000 to \$28,000,000 and update certain**  
6 **standard contractual clauses.**

8 WHEREAS, the Office of Contract Administration, by competitive bidding,  
9 developed the Technology Store procurement method for the purchase of products and  
10 services related to Information Technology; and

11 WHEREAS, En Pointe is one of the three products vendors who are part of the  
12 Technology Store; and,

13 WHEREAS, the original contract with En Pointe is dated January 1, 2009; has a  
14 term of three years, through December 31, 2011, with possible extensions through  
15 December 31, 2013, and has a contract amount of \$24 million; and

16 WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors approved the original contract on December  
17 9, 2008 by Resolution #508-08.

18 WHEREAS, the Office of Contract Administration estimates that the money  
19 projected to be spent with En Pointe could reach the contract's contract amount in the  
20 reasonably near future; and

21 WHEREAS, Charter section 9.118, "Contract and Lease Limitations," subsection  
22 (b), requires Board of Supervisors approval of any contract estimated to exceed \$10  
23 million in expenditures or amendments exceeding \$500,000 to such contracts; now,  
24 therefore, be it

1           RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Office of Contract  
2 Administration to enter into the First amendment to the contract with En Pointe to update  
3 the standard contractual clauses; and be it

4           FURTHER RESOLVED, that said Amendment shall increase the contract amount  
5 for the contract with En Pointe from \$24 million to \$28 million.
