
WHEREAS, The Planning Department has verified that the area is properly zoned and recommends approval; and,

RESOLVED, That in accordance with Section 23958.4 of the California Business and Professions Code, the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby determines for the foregoing reasons that the transfer of a Type 20 off-sale beer and wine license to Scot Plewacki, for Fatted Calf, will serve the public convenience or necessity of the people of the City and County of San Francisco.

Conditions: (1) Sales of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted only between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. daily. (2) No more than 10 % of the square footage of the premises will be used for the display of alcoholic beverages. (3) The sale of beer or malt beverages in quantities of 16 oz., 22 oz., 32 oz., 40 oz., or similar size containers is prohibited, except for microbrews, craft brews, organic and specialty malt products sold under such designations as stout, porter, IPA and ESB. This condition is intended to

eliminate high alcohol, low-cost products that are frequently abused, but not prevent the sale of specialty and craft beer products. (4) No noise shall be audible beyond the area under the control of the licensee. (5) No persons under the age of 21 shall sell, furnish or deliver alcoholic beverages. (6) Loitering (loitering is defined as "to stand idly about; linger aimlessly without lawful business") is prohibited on any sidewalks or property adjacent to the licensed premises under the control of the licensee as depicted on the ABC-257. (7) There shall be no cups, glasses or similar receptacles commonly used for the drinking of beverages, sold, furnished, or given away at the petitioner's premises in quantities of less than twenty-four in their original multi-container package. (8) All ice shall be sold at or above prevailing prices in the area and in quantities of not less than three (3) pounds per sale and shall not be given away free.




