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Amendment No. 4 TO THE 2006-2012 MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN

THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO

AND

INTERNATIONAL FEDERATION OF PROFESSIONAL AND TECHNICAL ENGINEERS, LOCAL 21

The parties hereby amend the Memorandum of Understanding as follows:

III.N. HEALTH AND WELFARE AND DENTAL INSURANCE

1. <u>City Contribution</u>

The City agrees to maintain health and dental benefits at present levels for the life of the 422. Agreement.

Fiscal Year 2010-2011

For "medically single employees"/Employee Only (i.e., benefited employees not 423. receiving this contribution paid by the City for dependent health care benefits), the City shall contribute all of the premium for the employees' own health care benefit coverage.

Fiscal Year 2011-12 and Thereafter

- 424. The City and the PEC will establish a labor management committee to begin meeting no later than October 1, 2010, concluding before December 31, 2010, to identify changes to MOU negotiated premium payments that would be anticipated to yield approximately \$3 million in savings annually in the City's employee health care cost, beginning Fiscal Year 2011-12. Effective July 1, 2011, employees who enroll in the Delta Dental PPO Plan shall pay the following premiums for the respective coverage levels: \$5/month for employee-only, \$10/month for employee + 1 dependent, or \$15/month for employee + 2 or more dependents.
- Should the committee not reach mutual agreement on another option, the following 425. goes into effect: for Fiscal Year 2011-12 and thereafter, for all employees enrolled in the City Plan in the medically single/Employee Only category, the City's contribution will be capped at an amount equivalent to the cost of the second highest cost plan for medically single/Employee Only enrollees. Employees who elect to enroll in the City plan in this category must pay the difference between the capped amount of the City plan described above and the cost of City plan coverage in the medicallysingle/Employee Only category.

If no mutual agreement on another option is reached as described in paragraph 425, and 426. if an employee's work location reasonably requires him or her to reside in a county in which there is no City HMO available, then the City shall pay for medicallysingle/Employee Only coverage under the City plan. The City shall contribute up to 75% of the dependent rate charged by the City to 427. employees for Kaiser coverage at the dependent plus two or more level.
