

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Amendment No. 1 TO THE 2010-2012 MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO

THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO AND

THE SAN FRANCISCO INSTITUTIONAL POLICE OFFICERS' ASSOCIATION

The parties hereby amend the Memorandum of Understanding as follows:

III.M. HEALTH AND WELFARE

1. Employee Health Care

- 196. The City agrees to continue to contribute the applicable rate per month directly into the City Health Service System for each employee who is a member of the Health Service System. The level of contribution is set pursuant to the Charter.
 - 2. Dependent Care Health Benefits
- 197. Amount of Employee Contribution to be Paid by the City. The City shall contribute up to \$635.91 per month per employee to provide for dependent coverage for employees with one or more dependents.
 - 3. Dental Coverage
- 198. Each employee covered by this agreement shall be eligible to participate in the City's dental program.
- 198a. Effective July 1, 2011, employees who enroll in the Delta Dental PPO Plan shall pay the following premiums for the respective coverage levels: \$5/month for employee-only, \$10/month for employee + 1 dependent, or \$15/month for employee + 2 or more dependents.
 - 4. Contributions While On Unpaid Leave
- 199. The City will cease payment of any and all contributions for employee health and dental benefits for those employees who remain on unpaid status, with the exception of approved sick leave or workers compensation, in excess of twelve (12) continuous weeks.
 - Single Employees

Fiscal Year 2010-2011

200. For "medically single"/Employee-Only employees (i.e., benefited employees not receiving the contribution paid by the City for dependent health care benefits), the City shall contribute all of the premium for the employee's own health care benefit coverage.

Fiscal Year 2011-12 and Thereafter

201. The City and the Public Employees Committee will establish a labor management committee to begin meeting no later than October 1, 2010, concluding before December 31, 2010, to identify

changes to MOU negotiated premium payments that would be anticipated to yield approximately \$3 million in savings annually in the City's employee health care cost, beginning Fiscal Year 2011-12.

- 202. Should the committee not reach mutual agreement on another option, the following goes into effect: for Fiscal Year 2011-12 and thereafter, for all employees enrolled in the City Plan in the medically single/Employee Only category, the City's contribution will be capped at an amount equivalent to the cost of the second highest cost plan for medically single/Employee Only enrollees. Employees who elect to enroll in the City Plan in this category must pay the difference between the capped amount of the City Plan described above and the cost of City Plan coverage in the medically single/Employee Only category.
- 203. If no mutual agreement on another option is reached as described in paragraph 202, and if an employee's work location reasonably requires him or her to reside in a county in which there is no City HMO available, then the City shall pay for medically single/Employee Only coverage under the City Plan.
