[Accept and Expend Grant - Port Security Grant Program - \$458,000]

Resolution authorizing the Police Department to retroactively accept and expend \$458,000 of FY2008 Port Security Grant Program (PSGP) Funds (Grant No. 2008-GB-T8-K063) from the Federal Emergency Management Agency.
