I've cherished reading my grandfather's diary entries about traveling by boat from Long Beach to attend the World's Fair and hearing my grandmother's stories of taking the ferry to San Francisco as a UC Berkeley student before the Bay Bridge was built.

I have cherished every moment of my 17+ year career in public service, which has been dedicated to aligning public resources with organizational goals and priorities. My journey began in the Environment Branch of the White House Office of Management and Budget (2007-2008), followed by two years in the San Francisco Mayor’s Office of Public Policy and Finance (2008-2011). I then spent eight years at the Port of San Francisco, serving as Budget Manager and later Finance Director (2011-2019). After that, I spent over three years as Chief Financial Officer at the San Francisco Unified School District (2019-2022). Since 2022, I have returned to the Port of San Francisco, first as Economic Recovery Manager and now as Interim Chief Financial Officer. Throughout my career, I have remained committed to responsible financial management and ensuring public resources are effectively allocated to advance the mission of the organizations I serve.

**Civic Activities:**

In addition to my career in public service, I have been deeply involved in my community. I served on my children’s School Site Council (SSC) and Parent Teacher Association (PTA) and have been active in youth athletics—first as a coach for my kids’ micro-soccer teams and now as a team manager for my son’s soccer team. I have also engaged with the Parents Coalition, using my experience as Chief Financial Officer of SFUSD to help parents better understand the district’s budgeting process and challenges. Most recently, I have been leading a “Girls Advocacy” initiative within our soccer club, advocating for greater investment in girls’ teams to ensure equal opportunities in the sport.
