Section 1. Findings.

A. The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in this Ordinance are in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (California Public Resources Code sections 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 10708 and is incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. The San Francisco Health Code is hereby amended by amending Section 128, to read as follows:

Sec. 128. PATIENT RATES.
