

In order to take advantage of the extensive experience and knowledge available throughout our communities, various Boards/Commissions/Committees/Task Forces have been established to bring that knowledge together. These groups and their membership requirements are established by legislation approved through the local, state, and/or federal government.

In addition to setting up the purpose and goals of the various groups, the governing legislation outlines the type of person - in terms of desirable skills and/or knowledge - who can contribute their knowledge and perspective. In this manner, a group of San Franciscans, who are representative of the City and County, can be active participants in addressing issues affecting the entire City and County.

1. 2. Submit an application ([http://www.sfbos.org/vacancy application](http://www.sfbos.org/vacancy_application))
(List all of the appropriate seat number(s) and/or category/categories for which you qualify. We request applications be received ten (10) days before the scheduled hearing.)

Applicants may also need to submit a Form 700, Statement of Economic Interests (<https://www.fppc.ca.gov/Form700.html>), along with their application for all bodies listed in [Campaign and Governmental Conduct Code, Section 3.1-103\(a\)\(1\)](#).

3. If the seat(s) you are applying for is vacant and requires the Board of Supervisors' confirmation, the Rules Committee may schedule your application for review. Applicants should expect to appear before the Rules Committee to speak on their qualifications and answer questions during a public hearing.
(There are no set instructions on what you are expected to present to the Rules Committee; however, a brief description of how your qualifications distinguish you from other applicants, reasons for your interest in the subject, and/or a short summarization on why you would make a good candidate is appropriate.)
4. The Rules Committee may or may not make a recommendation for appointment. 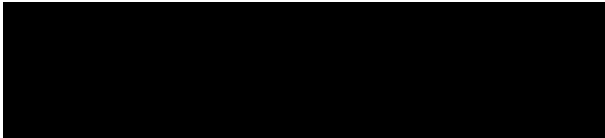

I am a criminal defense attorney, representing numerous clients currently housed in both active county jails. My job requires that I go to the jails, and that I work with the infrastructure of the Sheriff's Department to access my clients. Additionally, my job takes me to 850 Bryant on a near-daily basis, where I work with and observe members of the Sheriff's office on duty.

My qualifications are informed by my uniquely San Franciscan background and experience. I am a 4th generation San Franciscan, of Irish and Jewish decent, born in the city just like both of my parents and all four of my grandparents, and now I am raising my daughter here. All of my forefathers left their respective homes on opposite sides of Europe to escape oppression and poverty. One great grandfather became a street-car driver on market street; his family was evicted from their apartment in the aftermath of the 1906 earthquake to make room for, and collect higher rents from wealthier residents who had been displaced by the fire. Another great grandfather was an immigrant carpenter with little work, raising a family of four on the Upper East Side of Manhattan, who was called to San Francisco in 1907 to help rebuild the city. The lessons of their experiences - persecution, poverty, immigration, and the values of good education, family, and community - were never lost on their descendants, including myself. San Francisco has provided the community from which my family was allowed to thrive and succeed without ever betraying those lessons.

Business and/or Professional Experience: 17 Years as a Criminal Defense Attorney

As stated, I am a criminal defense attorney, representing numerous clients currently housed in both active county jails. I served as a public defender for 10 years, between two other counties, and I have been in private practice in San Francisco since April 2018. My first job upon college graduation was at the Board of Supervisors, from 2000-2001. Between working at City Hall, 850 Bryant, and both jails, I have had a close view of the work the Sheriff's deputies perform.

I understand law enforcement from the perspective of a criminal defense attorney, but I also know enough deputies and police officers on a personal level to understand that oversight requires the right combination of 1) understanding policy and 2) empathizing with the people to whom any such policies apply - which policies require strict application and enforcement, and which should allow for flexibility and second chances.

I was active in local civics between my college graduation in 2000 and the beginning of law school in 2003. I have been eager to re-engage.

Since then, I have been on two non-profit boards, including the San Francisco Criminal Trial Lawyers Association, of which I have been president for three years.
