Ordinance amending the San Francisco Administrative Code by adding Section 10.100-371 to establish the Department of Public Works Greening Fund as a category six fund.

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by adding Section 10.100-371, to read as follows:

SEC. 10.100-371. DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS GREENING FUND.

- (a) Establishment of Fund. The Department of Public Works Greening Fund is hereby established as a category six fund for the purpose of receiving all cash gifts, donations and contributions of money that may from time to time be offered to the City and County to pay for Department of Public Works design, construction and/or maintenance of Greening Projects.

 "Greening Projects" shall mean projects designed to establish public landscaped areas, gardens and plazas in San Francisco's streets and public rights-of-way including, but not limited to, Pavement to Parks projects.
- (b) Use of Fund. All monies deposited into the fund shall, consistent with the gift, donation, or contribution, be expended for implementation and/or maintenance of Greening Projects and improvements prescribed by the City's Better Streets Plan to calm traffic, improve pedestrian and bicycle safety and to manage storm water runoff.
- (c) Administration of Fund. The Director of the Department of Public Works is authorized to accept all gifts to the Department of Public Works for the uses and purposes described in subsection

(b), including but not limited to gifts of money, equipment, property, supplies and services. Gifts to the fund are exempt from the provisions of Administrative Code Section 10.100-305.

LEGISLATIVE DIGEST

[Administrative Code – Public Works Greening Fund]

Ordinance amending the San Francisco Administrative Code by adding Section 10.100-371 to establish the Department of Public Works Greening Fund as a category six fund.

Existing Law

Under existing law, the Department of Public Works may accept gifts for greening projects. Administrative Code Section 10.100-305 requires the Board of Supervisors to approve any gift of cash or goods of a market value greater than \$10,000 by resolution.

Amendments to Current Law

The Department of Public Works may accept gifts of over \$10,000 for greening projects without Board of Supervisors approval. These funds would be administered by the Controller in category six fund.
