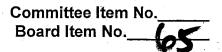

A THREE LOT SUBDIVISION AND SIX RESIDENTIAL UNIT CONDOMINIUM PROJECT

The City Planning Department in its letter dated March 26, 2009, stated that the subdivision is in conformity with the General Plan and the Priority Policies of City Planning Code Section 101.1., subject to noted conditions.

The Director of Public Works, the Advisory Agency, acting in concurrence with other City agencies, has determined that said Final Map complies with all subdivision requirements related thereto.
