11	Section 1. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by revising		
12	Chapter 10, Article 1, Section 10.1:		
13	SEC. 10.1. ANNUAL EC	ONOMIC STATEMENT—CITY-FUNDED ORGANIZATIONS.	
14	Every nonprofit cor	poration, organization or other legal entity, receiving funding from or	
15	through the City and County to provide direct services to the public (except local, State or		
16	federal governmental entities) that has not, within the past twelve months, provided to a City		
17	Department that awarded and/or is monitoring its City contract or grant the information required by		
18	the annual economic statement described in this section 10.1, shall file with the Department of		
19	Administrative Services an annual economic statement, on a form to be provided by the		
20	Department, on or before April 1st of each year setting forth the following information:		
21	(a) Name of the chief executive officer, employee, or other person possessing daily		
22	managerial responsibilities;		
23	(b) Name of all off	icers or directors and the names of all other boards of directors on	
24	which they serve; and		
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1	(c) Total expenditures during calendar or fiscal year, whichever is applicable; and		
2	budget for current calendar or fiscal year, whichever is applicable, setting forth the source of		
3	all monies received or budgeted and a program-by-program description of all monies		
4	expended or budgeted.		
5	All entities applying for or receiving monies from the City and County who have neither		
6	(i) provided to the City Department information equivalent to that required by the annual economic		
7	<u>statement described in this section 10.1 within the past twelve months, nor</u> <del>do not have on</del> <u>(ii)</u> file <u>d</u> a		
8	current annual economic statement, shall file a statement such information with the City		
9	Department or City Administrator in the same manner and form as the statement described above		
10	before any public monies shall be approved.
