[Approval of an Additional Six (6) Months for Planning Commission Review]

Resolution extending by six (6) months the prescribed time within which the Planning Commission may render its decision on a proposed Ordinance that would amend the Planning Code by amending Sectional Map HT07 of the Zoning Map of the City and County of San Francisco to rezone the property located at 2301 Market Street on the corner of Market and Noe Streets from a 50-X height and bulk limit to a 65-X height and bulk limit; and making environmental findings and findings of consistence with the General Plan and priority policies of Planning Code Section 101.1.

WHEREAS, On March 1, 2011, Supervisor Wiener introduced legislation to initiate the process amending San Francisco Planning Code by amending Sectional Map HT07 of the Zoning Map of the City and County of San Francisco to rezone the property located at 2301 Market Street on the corner of Market and Noe Streets from a 50-X height and bulk limit to a 65-X height and bulk limit; and making environmental findings and findings of consistence with the General Plan and priority policies of Planning Code Section 101.1. A copy of said legislation is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 110224 and is incorporated herein by reference; and,

WHEREAS, On or about March 16, 2011, the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors referred the proposed ordinance to the Planning Commission, which currently is reviewing the proposed ordinance; and,

WHEREAS, The Board, in accordance with Planning Code Section 306.4(d) may, by resolution, extend the prescribed time within which the Planning Commission is to render its decision on proposed amendments to the Planning Code that the Board of Supervisors initiates; and,

WHEREAS, On April 19, 2011, the Board of Supervisors passed Resolution Number 176-11 granting an extension of the prescribed time within which the Planning Commission may render its decision on the proposed ordinance for approximately 90 days, or until September 16, 2011; and,
