WHEREAS, Standing Against Global Exploitation (SAGE) is the recipient of a grant
 award from the Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Refugee Resettlement
 supporting The Cross Bay Collaborative to Combat Human Trafficking (CBC); and,

WHEREAS, With a portion of these funds, SAGE has subcontracted with DPH in the
amount of \$60,000 for the period of July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012; and,

WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, SAGE requires the City to
enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the
Board of Supervisors in File No.111038; which is hereby declared to be a part of this
resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

WHEREAS, The full project period of the grant starts on July 1, 2011 and ends on June
30, 2014, with years two and three subject to availability of funds and satisfactory progress of
the project; and,

WHEREAS, The purpose of this project is to create the infrastructure for a sustainable,
 community-based anti-trafficking identification and response protocol among and within San
 Francisco; and,
