## **RESOLUTION NO.**

 [Approval of a Six Month Extension for Planning Commission Review of Japantown Special Use District Provisions (File No. 110768)]

Resolution extending by six months the prescribed time within which the Planning
Commission may render its decision on a proposed Ordinance (File No. 110768) that
would amend the Planning Code by amending Section 249.31 to prohibit a Medical
Service Use or a Business or Professional Use on the ground floor in the area zoned
NC-2 in the Japantown Special Use District; and making environmental findings and
findings of consistence with the General Plan and priority policies of Planning Code
Section 101.1.

WHEREAS, On June 21, 2011, Supervisor Mirkarimi introduced legislation to initiate the process amending San Francisco Planning Code by amending Section 249.31 to prohibit a Medical Service Use or a Business or Professional Use on the ground floor in the area zoned NC-2 in the Japantown Special Use District; and making environmental findings and findings of consistence with the General Plan and priority policies of Planning Code Section 101.1. A copy of said legislation is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 110768 and is incorporated herein by reference; and,

WHEREAS, On or about June 30, 2011, the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors referred the proposed ordinance to the Planning Commission, which currently is reviewing the proposed ordinance; and, 21

WHEREAS, The Board, in accordance with Planning Code Section 306.4(d) may, by resolution, extend the prescribed time within which the Planning Commission is to render its decision on proposed amendments to the Planning Code that the Board of Supervisors initiates; and,
