Resolution responding to the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court on the findings and recommendations contained in the 2010-2011 Civil Grand Jury Report entitled "Log Cabin Ranch Moving Towards Positive Horizons" and urging the Mayor to cause the implementation of accepted findings and recommendations through his/her department heads and through the development of the annual budget.

WHEREAS, Under California Penal Code Section 933 et seq., the Board of Supervisors must respond, within 90 days of receipt, to the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court on the findings and recommendations contained in Civil Grand Jury Reports; and

WHEREAS, In accordance with Penal Code Section 933.05(c), if a finding or recommendation of the Civil Grand Jury addresses budgetary or personnel matters of a county agency or a department headed by an elected officer, the agency or department head and the Board of Supervisors shall respond if requested by the Civil Grand Jury, but the response of the Board of Supervisors shall address only budgetary or personnel matters over which it has some decision making authority; and

WHEREAS, The Civil Grand Jury has requested that the Board of Supervisors respond to Finding Nos. 5 and 6 as well as Recommendation Nos. 5 and 6 contained in the subject Civil Grand Jury report; and

WHEREAS, Finding No. 5 states: "Due to the age of the buildings (circa, 1950), structural improvements to the Ranch are greatly needed;" and,

WHEREAS, Recommendation No. 5 states: "The Mayor and the Board of Supervisors should immediately provide capital funding for long neglected infrastructure needs;" and

WHEREAS, Finding No. 6 states: "The Grand Jury believes that the Log Cabin Ranch is under-utilized and the recent positive programmatic changes warrant expansion to maximum capacity;" and
