[Urging the Municipal Transportation Agency to Halt Action on the Transfer of Credit Card

Resolution urging the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency to reconsider and abandon the decision to shift the burden of credit card merchant charges to the city cab drivers.

WHEREAS, Municipal Transportation Agency (MTA), seeks to overturn San Francisco Transportation Code Section 1106 (p)(6), that forbids cab companies from charging cab drivers a fee for the redemption of credit card charges; and,

WHEREAS, This change would allow companies to charge city taxi drivers a fee of 5 percent for every credit card transaction; and,

WHEREAS, Cab drivers will be discouraged to accept credit card payments as a result of the fee-shift; and,

WHEREAS, This action will make it more difficult for residents and visitors to use credit cards, placing an unnecessary burden on the population and conflicting with the city's interest in insuring public interest and welfare; and,

WHEREAS, The proposed action will make cab drivers more susceptible to robbery and assault as they will be carrying larger amounts of cash, making worse the dangers that cab drivers face and in spite of the fact that cab drivers are victim to the highest homicide rate of workers in the United States; and,

WHEREAS, It is unfair to pass legitimate costs of doing business onto workers. creating a financial burden and further limiting opportunities of workers who have no guaranteed wage, no benefits, and no retirement plans; now, therefore, be it
